

## **BICYCLE ADVISORY COMMITTEE**

**MISSION:** To provide coordination and unity among the various governmental and non-governmental agencies within Maricopa County relating to bicycling.

**FORMATION AUTHORITY:** The Committee was established by the Board of Supervisors on October, 25, 1989. No application statutory guidelines.

**COMPOSITION:** B-laws, Article III: Section 1. The Committee shall be composed of ten members. Section 2. The Board of Supervisors shall appoint members to the Committee for three-year terms. Each Board member may select two representatives to the Committee. Section 3. The Committee may recommend to the Board of Supervisors any number of honorary members or ex officio members to the Committee.

**DUTIES AND POWERS:** By Policy: Act in an advisory role to the Board of Supervisors on matters pertaining to bicycling and related facilities and plans. Recommend and coordinate with other government or private entities routes for bicycles which shall comprise a county-wide master plan of bike trails and routes. Review, advise and determine rules and regulations for the operation of the Maricopa County Bikeway System as provided under the authority of A.R.S. § 28-641, 28-643 or 11-935. Serve as a “sounding board” for residents of Maricopa County relating to bicycling and related fields and programs. Assist in the development of increased public understanding and support for bicycle programs. Assist in developing and maintaining good relations with national, state and local organizations, associations and groups involved in bicycling. Make recommendations regarding policies for the operation of the bikeway system. Review, advise and recommend establishment of fees, if any for bicycle programs and facility fees.

**MEETINGS:** Meetings are held quarterly at MCDOT.
