CRIMINAL JUSTICE SYSTEM NEWS – AUGUST 2007

Adult Incarceration

Bookings increased from July (11,035) to an all-time high of 11,640. The **Average Daily Population slightly increased** from 9,562 to 9,589. The **pretrial population slightly decreased** in August (6,483) compared to July (6,494). The **sentenced and agency hold populations increased:** sentenced from 2,687 to 2,721 and agency holds only moved slightly from 333 to 334. **Overall ALOS decreased more than a day**, from 26.9 to 25.6 days. **The ALOS for sentenced decreased** from 26.5 to 25.62 days and **ALOS for agency holds increased** from 59.7 to 62.2 days. **Pretrial ALOS slightly increased** from 7.3 to 7.5 days.

Superior Court Filings & Case Processing

Criminal filings increased from July's 3,661 to an all-time high of 3,861 in August. **Terminations increased** from 3,210 to 3,400. The resulting clearance rate was 88.1%. **The active pending case inventory increased**, as it has every month since January, from 11,296 in July to 11,426 (most ever). **Filings into RCC increased** in August (2,254) compared to July (2,112)), while **filings into EDC increased** from 1,264 in July to 1,341 in August. **The number of trials increased** from 77 in July to 93 in August. **The trial rate also increased**, from 2.1% to 2.4.

Justice Court Filings

Forcible detainer filings increased slightly from July's 7,420 to 7,576 in August. Overall, August total filings were 38,322 (all-time high) compared to July's 35,869.

Adult Probation


Pretrial general and intensive supervision increased from July to August: general from 723 to 766 (highest since October 2006 - 818); intensive from 1,108 to 1,156 (highest since October 2006 – 1,193). Electronic monitoring decreased slightly, from 241 to 234. **Levels of standard probation supervision increased** from 30,027 to 30,853, inversely **levels of intensive probation supervision decreased** from 1,184 in July to 1,132 in August.

Juvenile Detention and Probation






Average Daily Jail Population




Average Daily Jail Population by Type



Overall Average Length of Stay in Jail




Average Length of Stay in Jail for Agency Holds




Average Length of Stay in Jail Pretrial vs Sentenced Population



Average Length of Stay in Jail for Pretrial Inmates




Sheriff's Office Transports for Inmate Court Appearances






Direct Filing began in May 2002



Direct Complaints into Superior Court




Grand Jury Indictments




Superior Court Trials Completed



Active Pending Criminal Case Inventory





Pretrial Supervision Defendant Monitoring Unit




Pretrial Supervision Defendants on Electronic Monitoring




Disposition of Cases Terminated


Average monthly dispositions by quarter



Status of Cases After 180 Days




Adult Probation Standard Supervision Population




Adult Probation Intensive Supervision Population




Juvenile Detention Average Daily Population



Juvenile Detention Average Length of Stay




Juvenile Electronic Monitoring
