CRIMINAL JUSTICE SYSTEM NEWS – August 2008

Adult Incarceration

Bookings decreased from July's 11,095 to 10,085 in August. The **Average Daily Population increased** from 9,513 to 9,551. The **Pretrial Population increased** in August (6,884) compared to July (6,783). The **Sentenced Population increased** from 2,300 in July to 2,364 in August. **Agency Hold Populations decreased** from 378 in July to 355 in August. **Overall Average Length of Stay (ALOS) decreased** in August from 26.6 to 26.1 days. **The ALOS for sentenced increased** from 24.7 days to 26.6 and **ALOS for Agency Holds also increased** from 56.4 days to 58.8. **Pretrial ALOS decreased** from 7.1 days to 6.6 days.

Superior Court Filings & Case Processing

Criminal filings decreased from July (3,140) to August (2,945). **Terminations decreased** from 3,382 to 3,311. The resulting **Clearance Rate** was 112.4%. **The Active Pending Case Inventory decreased** from 12,057 in July to 11,837 in August. **Filings into RCC decreased** in August (1,822) compared to July (1,881). **Filings into EDC decreased** from 1,027 in July to 862 in August. **The Number of Trials Completed increased** from 77 in July to 82 in August. **The Trial Rate** was 2.8%.

Justice Court Filings

Forcible Detainer Filings increased from July (6,764) to August (7,197). **Overall Filings decreased** from July (35,227) to August (34,893).


Adult Probation

Pretrial General Supervision increased from July (693) to August (703); **Pretrial Intensive Supervision increased slightly**, from 1,282 in July to 1,285 in August. **Electronic Monitoring decreased** from 269 to 265. Levels of Standard Probation Supervision decreased slightly from July (29,889) to (29,870); **Levels of Intensive Probation Supervision decreased** from 996 in July to 994 in August.


Juvenile Detention and Probation

The **Average Daily Detention Population increased** from 264 in July to 273 in August. ADP is down 33% when comparing FY08 to FY09. **ALOS decreased slightly** from 13.7 to 13.5 days. ALOS is down 20.6% when comparing FY08 to FY09. **Commitments to ADJC decreased** from 36 in July to 32 in August. **Standard probation decreased** from 4,494 in July to 4,376 in August. **Intensive Probation also decreased** from 465 to 445.




Average Daily Jail Population




Average Daily Jail Population by Type



Overall Average Length of Stay in Jail




Average Length of Stay in Jail for Agency Holds




Average Length of Stay in Jail Pretrial vs Sentenced Population



Average Length of Stay in Jail for Pretrial Inmates




Sheriff's Office Transports for Inmate Court Appearances






Direct Filing began in May 2002



Direct Complaints into Superior Court




Grand Jury Indictments




Superior Court Trials Completed



Active Pending Criminal Case Inventory





Pretrial Supervision Defendant Monitoring Unit




Pretrial Supervision Defendants on Electronic Monitoring




Disposition of Cases Terminated

Average monthly dispositions by quarter



Status of Cases After 180 Days




Adult Probation Standard Supervision Population



Adult Probation Intensive Supervision Population




Juvenile Detention Average Daily Population


Juvenile Detention Average Length of Stay
