CRIMINAL JUSTICE SYSTEM NEWS – February 2009

Adult Incarceration

Bookings decreased from 11,155 in January to 9,989 in February. The **Average Daily Population decreased** from 9,376 to 9,056. The **Pretrial Population decreased** in February (6,398) compared to January (6,473). The **Sentenced Population increased** to 2,238 in February compared to 2,151 in January. **Agency Hold Populations also increased slightly** from 355 in January to 359 in February. **Overall Average Length of Stay (ALOS) decreased** in February from 26.0 days to 25.6 days. **The ALOS for Sentenced increased** from 23.8 to 24.3; while the **ALOS for Agency Holds decreased** from 66 to 61. **Pretrial ALOS increased slightly** from 6.5 to 6.6.

Superior Court Filings & Case Processing

Criminal filings increased from January (2,854) to February (2,957). **Terminations decreased** to 2,907 in February from 3,278 in January. The resulting **Clearance Rate** was 98.3%. **The Active Pending Case Inventory decreased** from 11,816 in January to 11,649 in February. **Filings into RCC decreased** in February (1,665) compared to January (1,737), which brought RCC filings to the lowest level since November 2006. **Filings into EDC increased** from 902 in January to 1,061 in February. **The Number of Trials Completed decreased** from 82 in January to 80 in February. **The Trial Rate was 2.7%**.

Justice Court Filings

Forcible Detainer Filings decreased from January (5,958) to February (4,688), which represented the lowest level since February 2007. **Overall Filings decreased** from January (38,013) to February (34,439).


Adult Probation

Pretrial General Supervision decreased from January (628) to February (607), which represents the lowest level since July 2002. **Pretrial Intensive Supervision decreased**, from 1,099 in January to 1,058 in February, which is the lowest since June 2007. **Electronic Monitoring remained 268**. Levels of **Standard Probation Supervision decreased slightly** from (30,167) in January to (30,148) in February; **Levels of Intensive Probation Supervision also decreased** from 996 in January to 984 in February.


Juvenile Detention and Probation

The **Average Daily Detention Population (ADP) increased** from 248 in January to 291 in February. ADP is down 22% when comparing FY08 to FY09. **ALOS decreased** from 13.0 days to 10.7. ALOS is down 13% when comparing FY08 to FY09. **Commitments to ADJC increased** from 34 in January to 40 in February. **Standard probation decreased** from 4,340 in January to 4,309 in February. **Intensive Probation decreased slightly** from 467 to 466.




Average Daily Jail Population




Average Daily Jail Population by Type



Overall Average Length of Stay in Jail




Average Length of Stay in Jail for Agency Holds




Average Length of Stay in Jail Pretrial vs Sentenced Population



Average Length of Stay in Jail for Pretrial Inmates




Sheriff's Office Transports for Inmate Court Appearances





Direct Complaints into Superior Court




Grand Jury Indictments





Superior Court Trials Completed




Active Pending Criminal Case Inventory




Justice Court Filings February 2009



Pretrial Supervision Defendant Monitoring Unit




Pretrial Supervision Defendants on Electronic Monitoring




Disposition of Cases Terminated

Average monthly dispositions by quarter



Status of Cases After 180 Days




Adult Probation Standard Supervision Population



Adult Probation Intensive Supervision Population




Juvenile Detention Average Daily Population


Juvenile Detention Average Length of Stay
