### ***CRIMINAL JUSTICE SYSTEM NEWS – JANUARY 2007***

#### **Adult Incarceration**

**Bookings increased** from 9,244 in December to 10,638 in January; this is a typical increase seen after the holidays. **Average Daily Population increased**, from 8,343 to 8,509; this is the first increase since April 2006. Over the same time period last fiscal year, ADP is down 10.2%. The **pretrial population increased** from December's 5,272 to January's 5,483. The **sentenced population decreased** 2,708 to 2,660 (fewest since March 2003 – 2,644). The **hold population remained nearly the same**, at 313.

While bookings and ADP increased, most measures of Average Length of Stay decreased in January.

**Overall ALOS decreased by over three days**, from 28.0 to 24.8 days. **The ALOS for agency holds decreased** from 70.4 to 67.3 days. **Pretrial ALOS increased** from 7.1 to 8.7 days. **Sentenced ALOS decreased** from 33.9 to 31.2 days. Breaking down the pretrial population, felony ALOS increased from 10.7 to 13.2 days and misdemeanor ALOS increased from 3.4 to 3.6 days.

#### **Superior Court Filings & Case Processing**

**Criminal filings and terminations increased** in January: filings from 3,065 to 3,520 and terminations from 2,355 to 3,048. The resulting clearance rate was 86.6%. **The active pending case inventory decreased slightly** from 10,047 to 10,010. **Filings into RCC and EDC increased in January compared to December:** RCC filings from 1,782 to 2,043 (highest since June 2006 – 2,072), EDC filings from 976 to 1,119 (highest since March 2006 – 1,181). **99 trials were completed in January** compared to 56 in December. **The January trial rate was 2.8%**, a percentage point higher than November's 1.8%.

#### **Justice Court Filings**

**DUI, all other criminal traffic, and civil traffic filings increased from December to January:** DUI from 1,294 to 1,507; all other criminal traffic from 5,102 to 6,299; and civil traffic from 11,893 to 14,474.

#### **Adult Probation**

**General and intensive pretrial supervision decreased slightly in January compared to December:** general from 665 to 664 and intensive from 1,040 to 990. However, **Electronic Monitoring increased slightly** from 249 to 251. All three types of supervision have increased when comparing the same periods for FY06 and FY07.

**Levels of standard probation supervision increased** from 30,280 in December to 30,354 in January.

**Levels of intensive probation supervision decreased** from 1,291 to 1,258.

#### **Juvenile Detention and Probation**


The **Average Daily Detention Population decreased** from 385 in December to 368 in January; this is the lowest level seen since December 2002 (349). **ALOS decreased** from 17.8 to 15.6 days; this is the lowest ALOS since February 2005 when it was also 15.6 days. **January's Electronic Monitoring was 139**, a decrease from December's 155. **Home detention decreased** from 249 to 220.

**Levels of juvenile standard and intensive probation increased:** standard from 4,182 to 4,279 and intensive from 503 to 525.




# Jail Bookings




# Average Daily Jail Population



# Average Daily Jail Population by Type




# Average Length of Stay in Jail for Agency Holds




# Average Length of Stay in Jail Pretrial vs Sentenced Population



# Average Length of Stay in Jail for Pretrial Inmates




# Sheriff's Office Transports for Inmate Court Appearances





# Superior Court Filings and Terminations



# Direct Complaints into Superior Court




# Grand Jury Indictments












# Pretrial Supervision Defendants on Electronic Monitoring




# Disposition of Cases Terminated

Average monthly dispositions by quarter



# Status of Cases After 180 Days




# Adult Probation Standard Supervision Population




# Adult Probation Intensive Supervision Population




# Juvenile Detention Average Daily Population



# Juvenile Detention Average Length of Stay




# Juvenile Electronic Monitoring
