### *CRIMINAL JUSTICE SYSTEM NEWS – January 2010*

#### **Adult Incarceration**

**Bookings increased** from 8,781 in December to 10,229 in January. The **Average Daily Population increased** from 7,608 in December to 7,777 in January. The **Pretrial Population increased** in January (5,456) compared to December (5,218). The **Sentenced Population increased** from 1,830 in December to 1,980 in January. The **Agency Hold Population increased** from 272 in December to 289 in January. **Overall Average Length of Stay (ALOS) decreased** from 25.6 days in December to 24.4 days in January. The **ALOS for Sentenced decreased** from 27.4 to 23.2 days, while the **ALOS for Agency Holds increased** from 60.3 to 67.5 days. **Pretrial ALOS decreased** from 6.9 to 6.0 days.

#### **Superior Court Filings & Case Processing**

**Criminal Filings decreased** from December (2,875) to January (2,705). **Terminations increased** from 2,497 in December to 2,638 in January. The resulting **Clearance Rate** was 97.5%. The **Active Pending Case Inventory decreased** from 11,819 in December to 11,603 in January. **Filings into RCC decreased** in January (1,630) compared to December (1,709). **Filings into EDC decreased** from 913 in December to 825 in January. The **Number of Trials Completed increased** from 41 in December to 63 in January. The **Trial Rate** was 2.3%.

#### **Justice Court Filings**

**Eviction Action Filings increased** from December (5,124) to January (5,497). **Overall Filings** in December were 62,272 including 31,885 filings from Civil Traffic Photo Enforcement.


#### **Adult Probation**

**Pretrial General Supervision decreased** from December (549) to January (539). **Pretrial Intensive Supervision decreased** from 859 in December to 831 in January. **Electronic Monitoring increased** from 226 in December to 234 in January. **Levels of Standard Probation Supervision increased** from 30,435 in December to 30,452 in January. **Levels of Intensive Probation Supervision increased** from 804 in December to 817 in January.


#### **Juvenile Detention and Probation**

The **Average Daily Detention Population increased** from 248 in December to 256 in January. **ALOS decreased** from 13.3 to 12.5 days. **Commitments to the Arizona Department of Juvenile Corrections decreased** from 44 in December to 24 in January. **Standard probation increased slightly** from 4,054 in December to 4,058 in January. **Intensive Probation decreased slightly** from 390 to 387.



Agency holds 4%



# Overall Average Length of Stay in Jail




# Average Length of Stay in Jail for Agency Holds




# Average Length of Stay in Jail Pretrial vs Sentenced Population



# Average Length of Stay in Jail for Pretrial Inmates




# Sheriff's Office Transports for Inmate Court Appearances








# Active Pending Criminal Case Inventory




# Direct Complaints into Superior Court




# Status of Cases After 180 Days


Average monthly dispositions by quarter






# Grand Jury Indictments








# Pretrial Supervision Defendant Monitoring Unit



# Pretrial Supervision Defendants on Electronic Monitoring




# Adult Probation Standard Supervision Population



# Adult Probation Intensive Supervision Population




# Juvenile Detention Average Daily Population

# Juvenile Detention Average Length of Stay


