### *CRIMINAL JUSTICE SYSTEM NEWS – JULY 2007*

#### Adult Incarceration

**Bookings decreased** from June's all-time high of 11,470 to July's 11,035. The **Average Daily Population slightly increased** from 9,532 to 9,562. The **pretrial population slightly increased** in July (6,494) compared to June (6,446); this is the largest pretrial population since November 2005 (6,508). The **sentenced and agency hold populations slightly declined:** sentenced from 2,689 to 2,687 and agency holds from 342 to 333.

**Overall ALOS increased two days**, from 24.9 to 26.9 days. This is highest ALOS since December 2006 (28 days). **The ALOS for sentenced and agency holds increased:** sentenced from 24.8 to 26.5 days and agency holds from 57.9 to 59.7 days. **Pretrial ALOS decreased** from 9.0 to 7.3 days.

#### Superior Court Filings & Case Processing

**Criminal filings decreased** from June's 3,735 to July's 3,661. **Terminations increased** from 2,996 to 3,210. The resulting clearance rate was 87.7%. **The active pending case inventory increased**, as it has every month since January, from 11,107 in June to 11,296 in July (most ever). **Filings into RCC decreased** in July (2,112) compared to June (2,350), while **filings into EDC increased** from 1,122 in June to 1,264 in July. **The number of trials increased** from 68 in June to 77 in July. **The trial rate also increased**, from 1.8% to 2.1%.

#### Justice Court Filings

**Forcible detainer filings increased** from June's 5,679 to July's 7,420. Overall, July's total filings were 35,869 compared to June's 35,730.

#### Adult Probation

**Pretrial general and intensive supervision increased** from June to July: general from 696 to 723 (highest since November 2006 – 743); intensive from 1,028 to 1,108 (highest since November 2006 – 1,130). Electronic monitoring decreased slightly, from 242 to 241.

**Levels of standard probation supervision decreased** from 30,226 to 30,027 while **levels of intensive probation supervision remained nearly the same** at 1,184.

#### Juvenile Detention and Probation


The **Average Daily Detention Population decreased** from 386 in June to 372 in July. **ALOS increased slightly** from 15.3 to 15.6 days. **Electronic Monitoring decreased** from June's 159 to July's 141. **Home detention decreased** from 266 in June to 252 in July.

**Levels of juvenile standard probation remained nearly the same** at 4,368. **Levels of juvenile intensive probation decreased** from 511 to 464 (lowest level since at least July 2001).





# Average Daily Jail Population by Type





## Overall Average Length of Stay in Jail




## Average Length of Stay in Jail for Agency Holds




# Average Length of Stay in Jail Pretrial vs Sentenced Population



# Average Length of Stay in Jail for Pretrial Inmates




# Sheriff's Office Transports for Inmate Court Appearances





# Superior Court Filings and Terminations



# Direct Complaints into Superior Court






# Superior Court Trials Completed



# Active Pending Criminal Case Inventory





# Pretrial Supervision Defendant Monitoring Unit




# Pretrial Supervision Defendants on Electronic Monitoring




# Disposition of Cases Terminated

Average monthly dispositions by quarter



# Status of Cases After 180 Days




# Adult Probation Standard Supervision Population




# Adult Probation Intensive Supervision Population




# Juvenile Detention Average Daily Population



# Juvenile Detention Average Length of Stay




# Juvenile Electronic Monitoring
