## Criminal Justice System

### *CRIMINAL JUSTICE SYSTEM NEWS – July 2008*

#### **Adult Incarceration**

**Bookings decreased** from June's 11,340 to July's 11,095. The **Average Daily Population increased** from 9,357 to 9,513. The **Pretrial Population increased** in July (6,783) compared to June (6,389). The **Sentenced Population decreased** from 2,462 in June to 2,300 in July. **Agency Hold Populations increased** from 364 in June to 378 in July. **Overall Average Length of Stay (ALOS) increased** in July from 24.8 to 26.6 days. **The ALOS for sentenced increased** from 23.8 days to 24.7, while the **ALOS for Agency Holds decreased** from 62.7 to 56.4 days. **Pretrial ALOS remained** 7.1 days.

#### **Superior Court Filings & Case Processing**

**Criminal filings increased** from June (3,107) to July (3,140). **Terminations increased** from 3,178 to 3,382. The resulting **Clearance Rate** was 107.6%. **The Active Pending Case Inventory decreased** from 12,209 in June to 12,057 in July. **Filings into RCC increased slightly** in July (1,881) compared to June (1,870). **Filings into EDC also increased** from 1,004 in June to 1,027 in July. **The Number of Trials Completed increased** from 67 in June to 77 in July. **The Trial Rate was** 2.4%.

#### **Justice Court Filings**

**Forcible Detainer Filings increased** from June (6,710) to July (6,764). **Overall Filings decreased** from June (40,179) to July (35,227).

#### **Adult Probation**

**Pretrial General Supervision decreased** from June (740) to July (693); **Pretrial Intensive Supervision increased**, from 1,257 in June to 1,282 in July. **Electronic Monitoring increased** from 251 to 269. **Levels of Standard Probation Supervision increased** from June (29,594) to July (29,889); **Levels of Intensive Probation Supervision decreased** from 1,023 in June to 996 in July.







# Average Daily Jail Population




# Average Daily Jail Population by Type



# Overall Average Length of Stay in Jail




## Average Length of Stay in Jail for Agency Holds




# Average Length of Stay in Jail Pretrial vs Sentenced Population



# Average Length of Stay in Jail for Pretrial Inmates




# Sheriff's Office Transports for Inmate Court Appearances







# Direct Complaints into Superior Court







# Superior Court Trials Completed




# Active Pending Criminal Case Inventory





# Pretrial Supervision Defendant Monitoring Unit




# Pretrial Supervision Defendants on Electronic Monitoring




# Disposition of Cases Terminated

Average monthly dispositions by quarter



# Status of Cases After 180 Days




# Adult Probation Standard Supervision Population



# Adult Probation Intensive Supervision Population




# Juvenile Detention Average Daily Population

# Juvenile Detention Average Length of Stay


