CRIMINAL JUSTICE SYSTEM NEWS – March 2010

Adult Incarceration

Bookings increased from 9,167 in February to 10,227 in March. The **Average Daily Population decreased** from 7,835 in February to 7,822 in March. The **Pretrial Population decreased** in March (5,416) compared to February (5,466). The **Sentenced Population increased** from 2,030 in February to 2,043 in March. The **Agency Hold Population increased** from 282 in February to 307 in March. **Overall Average Length of Stay (ALOS) increased** from 23.9 days in February to 27 days in March. The **ALOS for Sentenced increased slightly** from 23.6 to 24.4 days, while the **Pretrial ALOS decreased** from 7.0 to 6.4 days. The **ALOS for Agency Holds increased** from 61.8 to 69.5 days.

Superior Court Filings & Case Processing

Criminal Filings increased from February (2,855) to March (3,274). **Terminations increased** from 2,767 in February to 3,147 in March. The resulting **Clearance Rate** was 96.1%. The **Active Pending Case Inventory increased** from 10,989 in February to 11,035 in March. **Filings into RCC increased** in March (1,946) compared to February (1,635). **Filings into EDC increased** from 1,004 in February to 1,074 in March. The **Number of Trials Completed increased** from 66 in February to 71 in March. The **Trial Rate** was 2.2%.

Justice Court Filings

DUI Filings increased from February (795) to March (845). All other **Criminal Traffic Filings increased** from 3,816 in February to 4,244 in March. **Civil Traffic Filings increased** from 10,414 in February to 12,281 in March. **Civil Traffic Photo Enforcement Filings decreased** from 34,945 in February to 33,081 in March. **Eviction Action Filings increased** from February (3,848) to March (4,294). **Overall Filings increased** from 63,621 in February to 66,111 in March.


Adult Probation

Pretrial General Supervision increased from February (541) to March (595). **Pretrial Intensive Supervision increased** from 833 in February to 863 in March. **Electronic Monitoring decreased slightly** from 233 in February to 228 in March. **Levels of Standard Probation Supervision decreased** from 30,654 in February to 30,478 in March. **Levels of Intensive Probation Supervision decreased** from 807 in February to 787 in March.


Juvenile Detention and Probation

The **Average Daily Detention Population decreased slightly** from 267 in February to 262 in March. **ALOS increased** from 12.6 to 13.1 days. **Commitments to the Arizona Department of Juvenile Corrections increased** from 38 in February to 47 in March. **Standard probation increased** from 4,054 in February to 4,082 in March. **Intensive Probation decreased** from 380 in February to 358 in March.




Average Daily Jail Population




Average Daily Jail Population by Type



Overall Average Length of Stay in Jail




Average Length of Stay in Jail for Agency Holds




Average Length of Stay in Jail Pretrial vs Sentenced Population



Average Length of Stay in Jail for Pretrial Inmates




Sheriff's Office Transports for Inmate Court Appearances








Active Pending Criminal Case Inventory




Direct Complaints into Superior Court




Status of Cases After 180 Days

Disposition of Cases Terminated












Pretrial Supervision Defendant Monitoring Unit



Pretrial Supervision Defendants on Electronic Monitoring




Adult Probation Standard Supervision Population



Adult Probation Intensive Supervision Population




Juvenile Detention Average Daily Population

Juvenile Detention Average Length of Stay


