## ***CRIMINAL JUSTICE SYSTEM Monthly Changes – March 2013***

### **Adult Jail Incarceration**

- **Bookings increased** from 8,292 in February to 9,290 in March.
- **Releases increased** from 8,241 in February to 9,221 in March.
- The **Average Daily Population (ADP) increased** from 7,977 in February to 7,981 in March.
- The **Pretrial ADP decreased** from 6,041 in February to 5,984 in March.
- The **Sentenced ADP increased** from 1,694 in February to 1,746 in March.
- The **Agency Hold ADP increased** from 187 in February to 191 in March.
- **Overall Average Length of Stay (ALOS) at release increased** from 24.8 in Feb to 26.6 in March.
- The **ALOS in days for Pretrial increased** from 7.0 in February to 9.0 in March.
- The **ALOS in days for Sentenced decreased** from 23.2 in February to 21.3 in March.
- The **ALOS in days for Agency Holds increased** from 69.6 in February to 71.9 in March.

### **Superior Court Filings & Case Processing**

- **New Criminal Case Filings increased** from 2,474 in February to 2,600 in March.
- **Case Terminations increased** from 2,348 in February to 2,777 in March.
- The resulting **Clearance Rate** was 107%.
- The **Active Pending Case Inventory decreased** from 11,127 in February to 11,021 in March.
- **Regional Court Center filings decreased** from 1,434 in February to 1,393 in March.
- **Early Disposition Court filings increased** from 789 in February to 948 in March.
- The **Number of Trials Completed increased** from 48 in February to 50 in March.
- The **Trial Rate** was 1.9%.

### **Justice Court Filings**

- **DUI Filings decreased** from 575 in February to 514 in March.
- All other **Criminal Traffic Filings decreased** from 2,959 in February to 2,787 in March.
- **Civil Traffic Filings decreased** from 9,117 in February to 7,789 in March.
- **Eviction Action Filings decreased** from 4,571 in February to 3,839 in March.
- **Total Filings decreased** from 23,994 in February to 22,804 in March.


### **Adult Probation**

- **Pretrial Standard Supervision decreased** from 1,660 in February to 1,628 in March.
- **Electronic Monitoring decreased** from 450 in February to 437 in March.
- **Adult Standard Probation Supervision increased** from 21,468 in February to 21,517 in March.
- **Adult Intensive Probation Supervision increased** from 704 in February to 731 in March.
- **Adult Unsupervised Probation Supervision decreased** from 7,247 in February to 7,123 in March.


### **Juvenile Detention and Probation**

- The **Average Daily Detention Population increased** from 199 in February to 211 in March.
- The **ALOS in juvenile detention decreased** from 13.7 in February to 12.4 in March.
- **Juvenile Standard Probation decreased** from 2,404 in February to 2,388 in March.
- **Juvenile Intensive Probation increased** from 217 in February to 243 in March.
- Monthly **commitments to Arizona Department of Juvenile Corrections** stayed the same with 17 in both February and March.




# Jail Releases




# Jail Bookings and Releases




# Average Daily Jail Population




# Average Daily Jail Population by Type




# Pretrial Average Daily Population




# Pretrial Felony Average Daily Population




# Pretrial Misdemeanor Average Daily Population




# Sentenced Average Daily Population



# Overall Average Length of Stay in Jail at Release




# Overall Average Length of Stay in Jail In Custody\*




# Average Length of Stay in Jail Pretrial vs Sentenced Inmates




# Average Length of Stay in Jail for Pretrial Inmates



# Average Length of Stay in Jail for Sentenced Inmates




# Average Length of Stay in Jail Agency Holds



# Sheriff's Office Transports for Inmate Court Appearances






# Active Pending Criminal Case Inventory




# Direct Complaints into Superior Court




# Status of Cases After 180 Days




# Superior Court Trials Completed




# Disposition of Cases Terminated

Average Monthly Dispositions by Quarter







# Justice Court Monthly Filings- Quarterly Average




# Pretrial Supervision Defendant Monitoring Unit Average Daily Standard Caseload





# Adult Probation Intensive Supervision Population




# Adult Probation Unsupervised Population


