### *CRIMINAL JUSTICE SYSTEM NEWS – May 2008*

#### **Adult Incarceration**

**Bookings increased** from April's 11,170 to May's 11,550. The **Average Daily Population also increased** from 9,029 to 9,130. The **Pretrial Population increased** in May (6,354) compared to April (6,224). The **Sentenced Population decreased** from 2,369 in April to 2,343 in May. **Agency Hold Populations increased slightly** from 378 in April to 381 in May. **Overall Average Length of Stay (ALOS) increased slightly** in May from 24.3 to 24.5 days. **The ALOS for sentenced increased** from 23.9 to 24.1 days, while the **ALOS for Agency Holds also decreased** from 66.8 to 59.5 days. **Pretrial ALOS decreased** from 7.3 to 5.6 days.

#### **Superior Court Filings & Case Processing**

**Criminal filings decreased slightly** from April (3,360) to May (3,277). **Terminations decreased** from 3,412 to 3,302. The resulting **Clearance Rate** was 100.8%. **The Active Pending Case Inventory increased slightly** from 11,691 in April to 12,045 in May. **Filings into RCC decreased** in May (1,946) compared to April (2,044). Inversely, **Filings into EDC decreased** from 1,048 in April to 1,043 in May. **The Number of Trials Completed decreased** from 98 in April to 72 in May. **The Trial Rate remained 2.2%**.

#### **Justice Court Filings**

**Forcible Detainer Filings increased** from April (6,302) to May (6,547). **Overall Filings decreased** from April (37,373) to May (36,934).


#### **Adult Probation**

**Pretrial General Supervision increased slightly** from April (738) to May (757); **Pretrial Intensive Supervision also increased**, from 1,207 in April to 1,230 in May. **Electronic Monitoring decreased** from 272 to 258. **Levels of Standard Probation Supervision increased** from 29,280 to 29,530; while **Levels of Intensive Probation Supervision decreased slightly** from 1,055 to 1,023.


#### **Juvenile Detention and Probation**

July through October 2007 were transitional months for conversion from JOLTS to iCIS. Due to programming changes, Standard Probation and JIPS data is unavailable for May. **Average Daily Population increased** from 337 in April to 347 in May. Comparing the same time period, **Average Length of Stay increased 12.5% to 13%**.




# Average Daily Jail Population




# Average Daily Jail Population by Type



# Overall Average Length of Stay in Jail




# Average Length of Stay in Jail for Agency Holds





# Average Length of Stay in Jail Pretrial vs Sentenced Population




# Average Length of Stay in Jail for Pretrial Inmates

— Overall Pretrial ALS




# Sheriff's Office Transports for Inmate Court Appearances







# Direct Complaints into Superior Court







# Superior Court Trials Completed




# Active Pending Criminal Case Inventory





# Pretrial Supervision Defendant Monitoring Unit




# Pretrial Supervision Defendants on Electronic Monitoring




# Disposition of Cases Terminated

Average monthly dispositions by quarter



## Status of Cases After 180 Days




# Adult Probation Standard Supervision Population



# Adult Probation Intensive Supervision Population




# Juvenile Detention Average Daily Population


# Juvenile Detention Average Length of Stay
