## Criminal Justice System

### *CRIMINAL JUSTICE SYSTEM NEWS – October 2008*

#### Adult Incarceration

**Bookings increased slightly** from 11,123 in September to 11,147 in October. The **Average Daily Population decreased** from 9,737 to 9,720. The **Pretrial Population decreased** in October (6,829) compared to September (6,964). The **Sentenced Population increased** to 2,447 in October compared to 2,348 in September. **Agency Hold Populations increased** from 379 in September to 388 in October. **Overall Average Length of Stay (ALOS) increased** in October from 26.3 to 27.0 days. **The ALOS for Sentenced decreased** from 25.8 to 25.6; while the **ALOS for Agency Holds increased** from 56.1 to 61.2. **Pretrial ALOS increased** from 6.9 to 7.5.

#### Superior Court Filings & Case Processing

**Criminal filings increased** from September (3,055) to October (3,222). **Terminations decreased** to 3,948 from 4,034, which was the highest level record. The resulting **Clearance Rate** was 122.5%. **The Active Pending Case Inventory decreased** from 11,692 in September to 11,474 in October. **Filings into RCC increased** in October (2,110) compared to September (1,857). **Filings into EDC decreased** from 923 in September to 841 in October. **The Number of Trials Completed decreased** from 94 in September to 77 in October. **The Trial Rate** was 2.4%.

#### Justice Court Filings

**Forcible Detainer Filings decreased** from September (7,197) to October (6,550). **Overall Filings decreased** from September (38,888) to October (36,001).


#### Adult Probation

**Pretrial General Supervision increased** from September (682) to October (703); **Pretrial Intensive Supervision decreased**, from 1,233 in September to 1,114 in October. **Electronic Monitoring decreased** from 265 to 251. Levels of **Standard Probation Supervision increased slightly** from (30,137) in September to (30,186) in October; **Levels of Intensive Probation Supervision decreased slightly** from 998 in September to 995 in October.


#### Juvenile Detention and Probation

The **Average Daily Detention Population (ADP) increased** from 289 in September to 317 in October. ADP is down 3% when comparing FY08 to FY09. **ALOS decreased slightly** from 12.9 to 12.8 days. ALOS is down 5% when comparing FY08 to FY09. **Commitments to ADJC decreased** from 42 in September to 36 in October. **Standard probation decreased slightly** from 4,328 in September to 4,314 in October. **Intensive Probation increased** 446 to 466.




# Average Daily Jail Population




# Average Daily Jail Population by Type



# Overall Average Length of Stay in Jail




## Average Length of Stay in Jail for Agency Holds




# Average Length of Stay in Jail Pretrial vs Sentenced Population



# Average Length of Stay in Jail for Pretrial Inmates




# Sheriff's Office Transports for Inmate Court Appearances







# Direct Complaints into Superior Court




# Grand Jury Indictments




# Superior Court Trials Completed



# Active Pending Criminal Case Inventory





# Pretrial Supervision Defendant Monitoring Unit




# Pretrial Supervision Defendants on Electronic Monitoring




# Disposition of Cases Terminated

Average monthly dispositions by quarter



## Status of Cases After 180 Days




# Adult Probation Standard Supervision Population



# Adult Probation Intensive Supervision Population




# Juvenile Detention Average Daily Population


# Juvenile Detention Average Length of Stay
