CRIMINAL JUSTICE SYSTEM NEWS – September 2008

Adult Incarceration

Bookings increased from 10,085 in August to 11,123 in September. The **Average Daily Population increased** from 9,551 to 9737. The **Pretrial Population increased** in September (6,829) compared to August (6,884). The **Sentenced Population increased** from 2,447 in September to 2,364 in August. **Agency Hold Populations increased** from 355 in August to 388 in September. **Overall Average Length of Stay (ALOS) decreased** in September from 26.7 to 26.3 days. **The ALOS for sentenced decreased** from 26.6 to 25.8 and **ALOS for Agency Holds also decreased** from 58.8 to 56.1. **Pretrial ALOS increased** from 6.6 days to 6.9.

Superior Court Filings & Case Processing

Criminal filings increased from August (2,945) to September (3,055). **Terminations increased** from 3,311 to 4,034, which is the highest level ever. The resulting **Clearance Rate** was 132.0%; the highest since January 1998. **The Active Pending Case Inventory decreased** from 11,837 in August to 11,692. **Filings into RCC increased** in September (1,857) compared to August (1,822). **Filings into EDC increased** from 862 in August to 923 in September. **The Number of Trials Completed increased** from 82 in August to 92 in September. **The Trial Rate** was 3.1%.

Justice Court Filings

Forcible Detainer Filings decreased from August (7,197) to (6,897). **Overall Filings increased** from August (34,893) to September (38,888).


Adult Probation

Pretrial General Supervision decreased from August (703) to September (682); **Pretrial Intensive Supervision decreased**, from 1,285 in August to 1,233 in September. **Electronic Monitoring remained** 265. Levels of Standard Probation Supervision increased from August (29,870) to (30,137); **Levels of Intensive Probation Supervision increased slightly** from 994 in August to 998 in September.


Juvenile Detention and Probation

The **Average Daily Detention Population increased** from 273 in August to 289 in September. ADP is down 24% when comparing FY08 to FY09. **ALOS decreased** from 13.5 to 12.9 days. ALOS is down 13.5% when comparing FY08 to FY09. **Commitments to ADJC increased** from 32 in August to 42 in September. **Standard probation decreased** from 4,376 in August to 4,328 in September. **Intensive Probation increased slightly** from 445 to 446.


Jail Bookings




Average Daily Jail Population




Average Daily Jail Population by Type



Overall Average Length of Stay in Jail




Average Length of Stay in Jail for Agency Holds




Average Length of Stay in Jail Pretrial vs Sentenced Population



Average Length of Stay in Jail for Pretrial Inmates




Sheriff's Office Transports for Inmate Court Appearances






Direct Filing began in May 2002



Direct Complaints into Superior Court




Grand Jury Indictments





Superior Court Trials Completed




Active Pending Criminal Case Inventory




Justice Court Filings September 2008



Pretrial Supervision Defendant Monitoring Unit




Pretrial Supervision Defendants on Electronic Monitoring




Disposition of Cases Terminated

Average monthly dispositions by quarter



Status of Cases After 180 Days




Adult Probation Standard Supervision Population



Adult Probation Intensive Supervision Population




Juvenile Detention Average Daily Population


Juvenile Detention Average Length of Stay
