Maricopa County is soliciting Letters of Interest and Qualifications from qualified firms to provide planning and architectural design services to the County for the remodel of the 3rd and 4th floors of the West Court Building, located at 111 S. 3rd Avenue, Phoenix, Arizona. Statements of Qualifications in the prescribed format must be addressed to Lynda Cull, Article 5 Procurement Officer, Maricopa County Facilities Management Department and shall be received by Maricopa County at the foregoing address no later than 10:00 a.m. (local time) on Tuesday, September 9, 2008.

The project will include renovation of the 3rd and 4th floors of the West Court Building to accommodate relocation of the MCSO Civil and AFIS/Records departments. The approximate size of the renovation area is 20,000 square feet. All mechanical, electrical and plumbing services are to be new. The project is located in Phoenix, Arizona at 111 S. 3rd Avenue. The construction budget is approximately \$2,000,000, excluding FF&E.

The scope of services will likely include programming, design, and construction administration for the following disciplines: architectural, structural, mechanical, electrical, plumbing, environmental (related to construction activity), signage/graphics, cost estimating, acoustical, audio/visual, telecommunications systems (data and phone), security systems and interiors.

The selected architectural firm may be assigned to work as a team with the selected program manager to deliver this project. It is anticipated that the construction of this project will be delivered by a Construction Manager at Risk to be selected following the selection of the Architect. The selected Architect may be required to assist in the selection of the contractor.

It is Maricopa County's policy to provide small businesses the opportunity to participate in the County's solicitation process and to be considered to fulfill the requirements for various commodities and services.
