

Maricopa County Air Quality Permitting Process

1. Air Quality Permit Application Submitted
2. Engineering Review of Application
3. Decision to Propose or Deny a Permit
4. If Permit Proposed - Public Notice and Posting with 30-Day Public Comment Period
5. If Request for Public Hearing Not Received - Air Quality Permit Issued for 5 Years
6. If Request for Public Hearing Submitted, Public Hearing Scheduled - Public Notice and Posting with 30-Day Public Comment Period
7. After Public Hearing, Hearing Officer Submits Recommendation to Control Officer
8. Control Officer Decides Whether or Not to Issue the Permit
9. Applicant, or Any Person Who Filed a Comment, Can Appeal the Decision to the Maricopa County Air Pollution Hearing Board
