



# STORMWATER POLLUTION POSTER CONTEST 2015



In the Phoenix area, stormwater runoff is carried by curbs or gutters into storm drains. Storm drains are separate from the sanitary sewer and **DO NOT** lead to a water treatment plant. Stormwater runoff and any pollutants that are picked up are discharged into our washes, rivers, and lakes without being treated.

**Who Can Enter?** 3<sup>rd</sup>-4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup>-6<sup>th</sup> grade students in Maricopa County

**When to Enter?** All entries must be postmarked by **March 27, 2015**

### Other Requirements:

- Poster size must be between 8 ½” x 11” and 14” x 22”
- Artwork must be original; any art medium is acceptable
- Poster must use the theme **“Keep It Clean: Stormwater Flows to Our Washes and Waterways”** and include a brief message and/or picture that support this theme. Image should be large enough to be easily seen and understood. Posters will be judged on originality, artwork, and message delivery. - Entries must have a 4” x 6” index card firmly attached to the back of the poster with the following information: **Student Name, Grade, Teacher’s Name, School Name, Address and Phone Number**
- By submitting artwork, the artist grants Maricopa County the permission to reproduce and display his/her artwork for use in the County’s Stormwater Program. Entries will not be returned.
