### *Septic Records at your fingertips MCESD announces new online tool*

Maricopa County Environmental Services Department (MCESD) is introducing a new online feature to make it easier and more convenient to obtain septic records.

This new portal gives the public the ability to search for septic documents and plans, to better locate their systems. By using this portal, it is no longer necessary to call or visit our department to request (and pay for) a septic search. "The goal of the Environmental Services Department is to modernize and enhance the many services which are provided to our stakeholders and this new on-line tool continues to move us in that direction" said Steven Goode, MCESD Director.

Before searching, it's helpful to gather all the pertinent information of the parcel being searched; for example: parcel number, lot number, and/or address. These items can be found on the Assessor's Web site at: [Maricopa.gov/assessor](http://Maricopa.gov/assessor).

All the forms and instructions for requesting or submitting a [Septic Research Request](#) can be found on the department's Web site ([esd.maricopa.gov](http://esd.maricopa.gov)) under the Water & Waste Management section.

The Septic Online Portal is a tool that MCESD is providing to the public so records can be accessed from home or anywhere with Internet access. The documents will generate in a PDF format that you can then View, Print, Save or Send in an Email, all at no cost to you.
