
Proposed Program Participants

An Alaskan Investigator with only a name and a license plate tracks down a suspect. There is no record in Alaska, but A SRFERS search shows:

- The vehicle crossed from Canada into Washington last week
- The suspect was arrested in San Diego
- A detective in Phoenix has also been running searches on the suspect



Phase II Deliverables (FY 2006)

- The addition of new regions to share the data initially exchanged in Phase I
 - each new agency must be a justice agency approved for data sharing with other justice agencies under the policies and procedures of the National Crime Information Center
- Expand on the data shared by adding up to three of the following data sources: DMV, CAL-PHOTO, Parole Leads, Rap sheet info, Parole Info and Probation Information
- Add a 'requery' functionality to the application
 - users will be able to use the results from one query as the input for a new query
- Develop an alert notification system
 - this system will allow users to setup an alert that will automatically notify them when a given name or license plate is queried by another user



The Mission

The mission of the State, Regional, and Federal Enterprise Retrieval System (SRFERS) Project is to increase effectiveness of public safety by demonstrating the ability to share justice information by utilizing the Global Criminal Justice Intelligence Sharing Plan; the Global Justice XML Data Model (GJXDM); and the infrastructure and resources of existing multi-jurisdictional justice systems.

How the System Will Work



Overview

Enhanced information sharing is critical to improving the capacity of law enforcement and other emergency agencies to protect the American public against terrorism and all other criminal acts that threaten its safety. The National Criminal Intelligence Sharing Plan outlines recommendations and steps to be taken to improve the information sharing capabilities of law enforcement and other emergency agencies. One of the key recommendations was “the efficient leveraging of existing efforts - the commitment to build on, not reinvent, substantial information sharing activities already under way.”

The **State, Regional, and Federal Enterprise Retrieval System (SRFERS)** Project seeks to implement the recommendations of the National Criminal Intelligence Sharing Plan by utilizing existing secure information sharing networks, systems, and applications to share critical criminal justice information between jurisdictions previously unavailable. Connecting these presently disparate, incompatible, and fragmented regional systems will demonstrate the effectiveness of leveraging existing information sharing efforts and markedly enhance the capabilities and effectiveness of public safety agencies throughout the nation.

Objectives

This multi-jurisdictional project proposes to accomplish the following objectives in Phase 1:

- Provide justice personnel with the ability to query critical data and photographs from neighboring jurisdictions/states
- Use existing secure justice networks to link multi-jurisdictional systems
- Address legal, privacy, and policy limitations and restrictions
- Document security architecture, credentialing, and auditing capabilities
- Develop generic GJXDM Version 3.0 transport/interfaces
- Produce a Model Implementation Plan and Check List for nationwide deployment
- Establish a National Policy Advisory Committee to provide appropriate cross-jurisdictional governance and policy
- Develop operational and functional requirements and a business case for subsequent phases to include other jurisdictions and data sources

- The ability for agencies to query NLETS for wanted vehicles crossing the ports of entry on the U.S. / Mexican border/Canadian border.
