INVITATION FOR BID FOR: SEEDS AND MULCH [NIGP 79005, 79054]

1.0 INTENT:

The intent of this Invitation for Solicitation is to establish a listing of qualified suppliers for certain seed and mulch products as defined herein (Attachment A). Multiple awards (listing of qualified suppliers) will be made. At the time a requirement is identified, requests for quotation (RFQ) will be issued to each qualified supplier. Award(s) will be made to the supplier meeting specification and offering the lowest price. Amendments, supplements and/or revisions will be effective upon receipt and approval of notice to the Department of Materials Management.

Suppliers shall comply fully with all conditions of this solicitation, for inclusion on the listing of qualified suppliers. Interested suppliers should understand that no pricing is requested with your reply to this Invitation for Bids. At the time a requirement is identified a request for quotation (RFQ) will be provided to all suppliers on the listing of qualified suppliers.

Participants should understand that all sections of the contract are applicable to this solicitation and that all requests for quotation (RFQ) (from qualified supplier listing) and all vendor responses to those requests for quotation are subject to the same provisions.

2.0 SPECIFICATIONS:**2.1 SEEDS**

Seed shall be labeled in accordance with Arizona State Laws and U.S. Department of Agriculture Rules and Regulations under the Federal Seed Act. Bag or container labels will be evidence of purity and germination. No seed will be accepted with a date of test of more than nine (9) months prior to the date of delivery to Maricopa County.

Seeds shall be delivered in the original sealed package, bearing the producer's guaranteed analysis for percentage of mixture and pure live seed (PLS). Seed that has become wet, moldy or otherwise damaged will not be accepted.

From time to time, the County is required by regulatory agencies to use materials harvested from sources within a specific distance of a project site. When such a requirement is anticipated, the County will make every effort to notify prospective bidders 12-18 months in advance of delivery that such material is needed. In all cases, the County will specify one of the following: 1. "Material needs to be Native to Sonoran Desert"; or 2. "Material needs to be harvested from within [X] miles of project site and vendor must sign a waiver attesting to this stipulation"; or 3. "Material must be 'Extension Service Tagged Lots' certifying harvest within [X] miles of project site".

2.2 WOOD FIBER MULCH

Shall consist of virgin wood fibers manufactured expressly from whole wood chips, incorporating (manufacturing process) a thermo - mechanical refining process (heat and pressure) to produce a product providing a more desirable "mat". The chips shall be processed to contain no growth or germination inhibiting factors. Fiber shall not be produced from recycled material such as sawdust, paper, cardboard, residue from paper plants or any other recycled cellulose material.

The wood cellulose fibers of the mulch must maintain uniform suspension in water under agitation and blend with grass seed fertilizer, and other additives to form homogeneous slurry. Upon applications, the mulch material shall form a blotter-like mat covering the ground. This mat shall have the characteristics of moisture absorption and percolation and shall cover and hold grass seed in contact with the soil.

The wood fiber mulch shall be dyed green to aid in visual metering during application. The dye shall be biodegradable and not inhibit plant growth. Mulch should conform to the following:

- A) Percent moisture content: 10.0% ± 3.0%
- B) Percent organic matter (wood fiber) 99.2% ± .8% OD Basis
- C) Percent ash content 0.8% ± 0.2% OD Basis
- D) PH 4.8 ± 0.5
- E) Water holding capacity (min) 1000 grams of water per 100 grams fiber

Acceptable products include Conwed and Silva Fiber, in all cases the term "or equal" applies.

Wood fiber mulch shall be packaged in units not to exceed 100 lbs. The package shall contain current labels, the manufacturers name and the net weight.

2.3 PAPER MULCH

Shall consist of 100%-recycled fibers derived from the recycling of paper products. The paper mulch shall be dyed green to aid in visual metering during application. The dye shall be biodegradable and not inhibit plant growth. Mulch shall conform to the following:

- A) Percent moisture content: 12.0% ± 3.0%
- B) Percent organic matter (paper) 98.0% ± 3.0%
- C) Percent ash content 1.5% ± 0.5%
- D) PH 5.5% ± 1.0%
- E) Water holding capacity (min) 1200 grams of water per 100 grams fiber

Paper mulch shall be packaged in units not to exceed 100 lbs. The package shall contain current labels, the manufacturers name and the net weight.

2.4 DELIVERY

The County is aware of the seasonal nature of the seeds portion of this bid. The awarded vendor shall advise the County concerning seasonal seeds availability date(s). Any products ordered shall be delivered F.O.B. destination, with the date, time and location to be determined by the County. If appropriate, all products shall be palletized (4' x 4') and shrink wrapped at no additional cost to the County. All products are to be delivered within seven (7) working days of notification by the County (seasonal seeds availability consideration noted above).

At times, when in the best interests of the County, pick up of orders may be made.

Quotes should include delivery costs, but not taxes.

2.5 EXPEDITED DELIVERY:

If the Using Agency determines that rush shipping or other alternate shipping is required, it shall notify the Contractor. The Contractor shall determine any additional costs associated with such delivery terms and communicate that cost to the Using Agency via fax or other reasonable means.

The Using Agency shall not advise the Contractor to proceed with shipment until acceptable terms are negotiated and a purchase order is issued. Upon determining that the additional costs are reasonable and proper, the Using Agency shall advise the Contractor to proceed.

Upon receipt of material and invoicing, the Using Agency shall ensure that any additional charges are in compliance with and do not exceed those costs stated in the Contract. The Using Agency shall retain all documents related to these costs within the agency purchase order file, for audit purposes.

2.6 SHIPPING DOCUMENTS

A packing list or other suitable shipping document shall accompany each shipment and shall include the following:

- 2.6.1 Name and address of the Contractor
- 2.6.2 Name and address of the County Agency
- 2.6.3 County Purchase Order number
- 2.6.4 A description of material shipped, including item number, quantity, number of containers and package number, if applicable.

2.7 INVOICING

All invoices shall contain the following information:

- 2.7.1 Name and Address of County Agency
- 2.7.2 Name of requestor and phone number
- 2.7.3 County purchase order number
- 2.7.4 Contract serial number
- 2.7.5 Description of items (s) shipped (price and quantity)
- 2.7.6 Taxable amount if applicable
- 2.7.7 Total amount of order

3.0 SPECIAL TERMS & CONDITIONS:

3.1 CONTRACT TERM:

This Invitation for Bid is for awarding a firm, fixed-price purchasing contract to cover a three (3) year period.

3.2 OPTION TO EXTEND:

The County may, at their option and with the approval of the Contractor, extend the period of this Contract up to a maximum of three (3) optional years. The Contractor shall be notified in writing by the Materials Management Department of the County's intention to extend the contract period at least thirty (30) calendar days prior to the expiration of the original contract period.

3.3 INDEMNIFICATION:

3.3.1 INDEMNIFICATION

To the fullest extent permitted by law, Contractor shall defend, indemnify, and hold harmless County, its agents, representatives, officers, directors, officials, and employees from and against all claims, damages, losses and expenses, including, but not limited to, attorney fees, court costs, expert witness fees, and the cost of appellate proceedings, relating to, arising out of, or alleged to have resulted from the negligent acts, errors, omissions or mistakes relating to the performance of this Contract. Contractor's duty to defend, indemnify and hold harmless County, its agents, representatives, officers, directors, officials, and employees shall arise in connection with any claim, damage, loss or expense that is attributable to bodily injury, sickness, disease, death, or injury to, impairment, or destruction of property, including loss of use resulting there from, caused by any negligent acts, errors, omissions or mistakes in the performance of this Contract including any person for whose acts, errors, omissions or mistakes Contractor may be legally liable.

The amount and type of insurance coverage requirements set forth herein will in no way be construed as limiting the scope of the indemnity in this paragraph.

The scope of this indemnification does not extend to the sole negligence of County.

3.4 **PROCUREMENT CARD ORDERING CAPABILITY:**

It is the intent of Maricopa County to utilize a procurement card that may be used by the County from time to time, to place and make payment for orders under the Contract. Contractors without this capability may be considered non-responsive and not eligible for award consideration.

3.5 **NO GUARANTEED QUANTITIES.**

The Contractor understands and hereby acknowledges that the County makes no representations nor guarantees the Contractor any minimum or maximum number of units of product(s) to be provided under this Contract

3.6 **ORDERING AUTHORITY.**

3.6.1 The Contractor should understand that any request for purchase of product(s) shall be accompanied by a valid purchase order, issued by Materials Management, or by a Certified Agency Procurement Aid (CAPA).

3.6.2 County departments, cities, other counties, schools and special districts, universities, nonprofit educational and public health institutions may also purchase from under this Contract at their discretion and/or other state and local agencies (Customers) may procure the products under this Contract by the issuance of a purchase order to the Respondent. Purchase orders must cite the Contract number.

3.6.3 Contract award is in accordance with the Maricopa County Procurement Code. All requirements for the competitive award of this Contract have been met. A purchase order for the product(s) is the only document necessary for Customers to purchase and for the Contractor to proceed with delivery of product(s) available under this Contract.

3.6.4 Any attempt to represent any product not specifically awarded under this Contract is a violation of the Contract. Any such action is subject to the legal and contractual remedies available to the County, inclusive of, but not limited to, Contract cancellation, suspension and/or debarment of the Contractor.

3.8 EVALUATION CRITERIA.

3.8.1 The evaluation of bids shall be based on, but will not be limited to, the following:

3.8.1.1 Compliance with specifications.

3.8.1.2 Determination of responsibility.

3.8.2 The County reserves the right to award in whole or in part, by item or group of items, by section or geographic area, or make multiple awards, where such action serves the County's best interest.

3.9 INSTRUCTIONS FOR PREPARING AND SUBMITTING BIDS.

Suppliers shall provide one (1) original hard copy (labeled), one (1) additional hard copy and one (1) copy of pricing (Attachment A). Suppliers are to identify their responses with the bid serial number, title and return address to Maricopa County, Department of Materials Management, 320 West Lincoln, Phoenix, Arizona 85003. **The owner, corporate official or partner who has been authorized to make such commitments must sign bids.**

3.10 SUPPLIER REVIEW OF DOCUMENTS.

The Supplier must review its Bid submission to assure the following requirements are met.

3.10.1 **Mandatory:** One (1) original hardcopy (labeled) and one (1) additional hardcopy.

3.10.2 **Mandatory:** Attachment "A", Pricing;

3.10.3 **Mandatory:** Attachment "B", Agreement; and

3.10.4 **Mandatory:** Attachment "C", References.
