- Case #/Title:** ES-2012-005: Revision to Maricopa County Environmental Health Code, Chapter 6 , Bathing Places – Public and Semipublic Swimming Pools – Pool Construction Requirements
- Supervisor Districts:** All Districts
- Overview:** Revise Chapter 6, to clarify pool construction requirements language to address instances of differing code interpretations by contractors and the Department due to lack of specificity, e.g., specify placement of “no diving tiles” at each depth marker in pools and minimum of two depth markers on the deck and at the waterline in spas. Specify size, color and location of tiles that must be placed on underwater steps, replacing requirement that steps must be “clearly visible.” In Section 14, Zero Depth Entry Pools, add to heading paragraph the missing references to complying with design requirements for public and semipublic pools, Sections 6 and 7.
