**Case #/Title:** ES-2013-007/Food Peddler Permit

**Supervisor Districts:** All Districts

**Overview:** Revisions to Maricopa County Environmental Health Code (MCEHC) Chapters I and VIII

This proposed revision would change the food peddler permit duration from one year to six months to provide customers with the flexibility to obtain a permit commensurate with the actual time period during which they conduct business. Many food peddlers operate on a seasonal basis only, and therefore do not need a one year permit. Creating a six month food peddler permit will reduce customer cost, increase customer satisfaction, and better align with their business model. The six month food peddler permit fee will be half of the current listed one year fee, therefore, the prorated fee remains the same.
