Early Intervention Services (EIS)	HIV counseling and testing, referrals, diagnostic services, periodic medical evaluations and therapeutic measures	N/A
Food Services	\$50/month food voucher to purchase nutritious food.	Up to 200%
Health Insurance Premium and Cost Sharing Assistance	Public or private health insurance premiums, including COBRA if danger of insurance lapsing	Up to 400%
Health Education/Risk Reduction	Health literacy provided through individual and group settings.	Up to 400%
Housing Services	First month's rent for clients entering housing.	Up to 300%
Mental Health Services	Assessments, counseling (individual, family, couples), support groups, psych evaluations, medication mgmt.	Up to 400%
Medical Nutrition Services	Assessments, RD nutrition counseling, nutrition supplements	Up to 300%
Oral Health Services	Dental insurance program and direct dental services	Up to 400%
Outpatient Ambulatory Medical Care	Medical visits, laboratory testing, diagnostic testing, specialist services, surgery services	Up to 400%
Outpatient Substance Abuse Services	Assessments, counseling (individual, family, couples), support groups, psych evaluations, medication mgmt, residential treatment	Up to 400%
Outreach	Identification of HIV+ individuals, linkage and relinkage to care.	N/A
Psychosocial Support Services	Assessments, counseling, support groups, non RD nutrition counseling services	Up to 400%
Transportation Services	Public transit passes Taxi services	Up to 200% Up to 400%
Treatment Adherence Counseling	Medication treatment adherence	Up to 400%
