Maricopa County Employees Get Permanent Recognition

County employees now have a permanent place of honor in the Maricopa County Complex. Three beautiful "Pillars of Honor" were dedicated on the plaza just in front of the court complex at 205 West Jefferson.

Each of the three columns honor a different group of employees: those who have retired with 30 or more years of service to the County; those who have lost their lives during service; and those who have received significant regional or national recognition.

Former Board of Supervisors' Chairman Fulton Brock came up with the idea for an employee recognition area. He appointed the task to a committee headed by Steve Conner.
