Dear Commissioner Arnett:

I'm writing to personally and strongly oppose the proposed Text Amendment of Chapter 2, Definitions, and Chapter 14, Articles 1403 and 1404 of the Maricopa County Zoning Ordinance (MCZO) relating to Off-Site Advertising Signs (Billboards).

Fountain Hills is an International Dark Sky Community and the mission of the Fountain Hills Dark Sky Association is to protect our dark skies by reducing artificial light at night, also known as light pollution. I view the proposed text amendment pertaining to lighted billboards and other lighted signs as a threat to Arizona's pristine night skies and the nocturnal creatures that depend on darkness for survival. If adopted, the amendments will enable a vast increase in light pollution to incorporated areas adjacent to unincorporated areas of Maricopa County, as well as in the corridor along the AZ State Route 87 between the eastern edge of the Fort McDowell Yavapai Nation and the community of Sunflower in the northeast corner of the county. Any increase in light pollution along that corridor would negatively impact existing night sky darkness in Fountain Hills and would also have negative impacts on nocturnal wildlife in the region.

Therefore, I strongly urge you to reject the proposed text amendments.

I am an astronomer at Arizona State University where we have access to some of the worlds best telescopes through the state system (Kitt Peak, Mt. Graham, Mt. Lemon, Mt. Hopkins, Lowell Observatory). The capability of these telescopes is limited by having a DARK night sky at night. From these mountain tops, you can see the glow of Phoenix already but the proposed billboards will make it even worse. As an astronomer, we have noticed, in a measurable way, that urban growth has affected the darkness of the night sky in the state. Rejecting this TA is the only way to ensure that Arizona will remain a world leader in the field of astronomy.

Honorable Chair Arnett & Members of the Commission:

Scenic Arizona hereby registers its opposition to the draft ordinance being put forward in the above-referenced case. This ordinance was not promulgated in response to any groundswell of public wishes, but rather only to benefit those who would profit from the further degradation of the visual environment. We would urge that you do not set this item for public hearing, and either take no action or continue the item so that there is an opportunity to rebut the one-sided documentation provided by the applicant, particularly such documentation that largely relies on self-interested sources.

We note that the allowance of electronic displays on billboards for the first time runs contrary to past involvement of the major astronomical observatories with Maricopa County and there is no indication that they have been contacted or engaged in the current process. We further note that there is no mention in the draft ordinance of potential conflict with state law (ARS Sec.28-7902), prohibiting electronic billboards within certain radii of observatories that extend well into Maricopa County. These radii were established as part of a legislative compromise in 2012, subsequent to successful litigation in which Scenic Arizona was a plaintiff and in which the court upheld the Arizona Highway Beautification Act prohibition of electronic billboards on state and federal jurisdiction highways.

More particularly, we oppose the following as being harmful to the visual environment: 1) any allowance of electronic displays on billboards; 2) increasing the area allowance of freeway billboards from 300 to 672 square feet; 3) increasing the height allowance of freeway billboards from 30 feet to 48 feet (or more in some cases); and 4) turning nonconforming use law on its head by allowing increases in intensity (adding electronic displays, decreasing separation requirements, or otherwise).

Again, we would urge that this item not be set for public hearing at this time.
