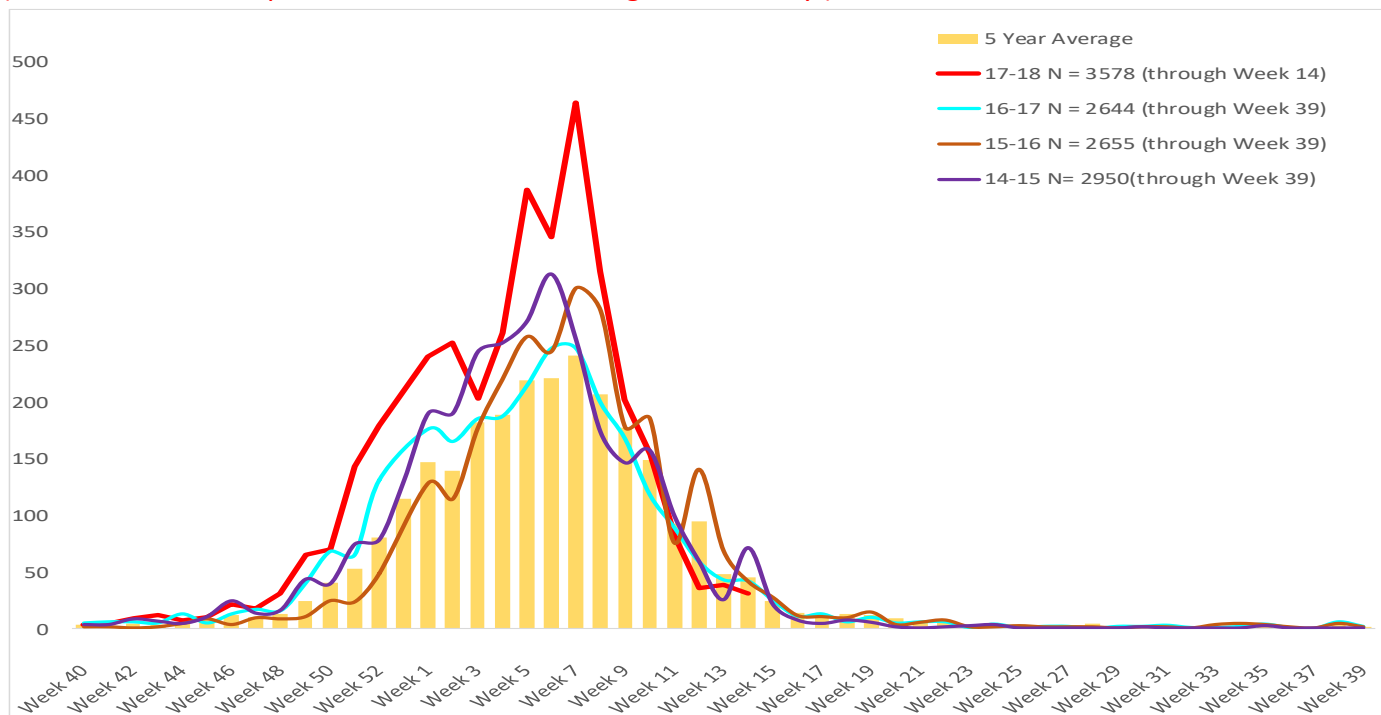

Respiratory Syncytial Virus (RSV)

The 2017-2018 RSV season starts on 10/1/2017(week 40) and continues through 9/30/2018(week 39). Through week 14 (4/1 – 4/7/2018), **3,578** RSV cases have been laboratory confirmed in Maricopa County. (These numbers are provisional due to a back-log in data-entry.)

% increase compared to 5 season average	42%	-56%
% increase compared to last week	1%	-18%

Those less than one year of age are most effected by RSV.
