

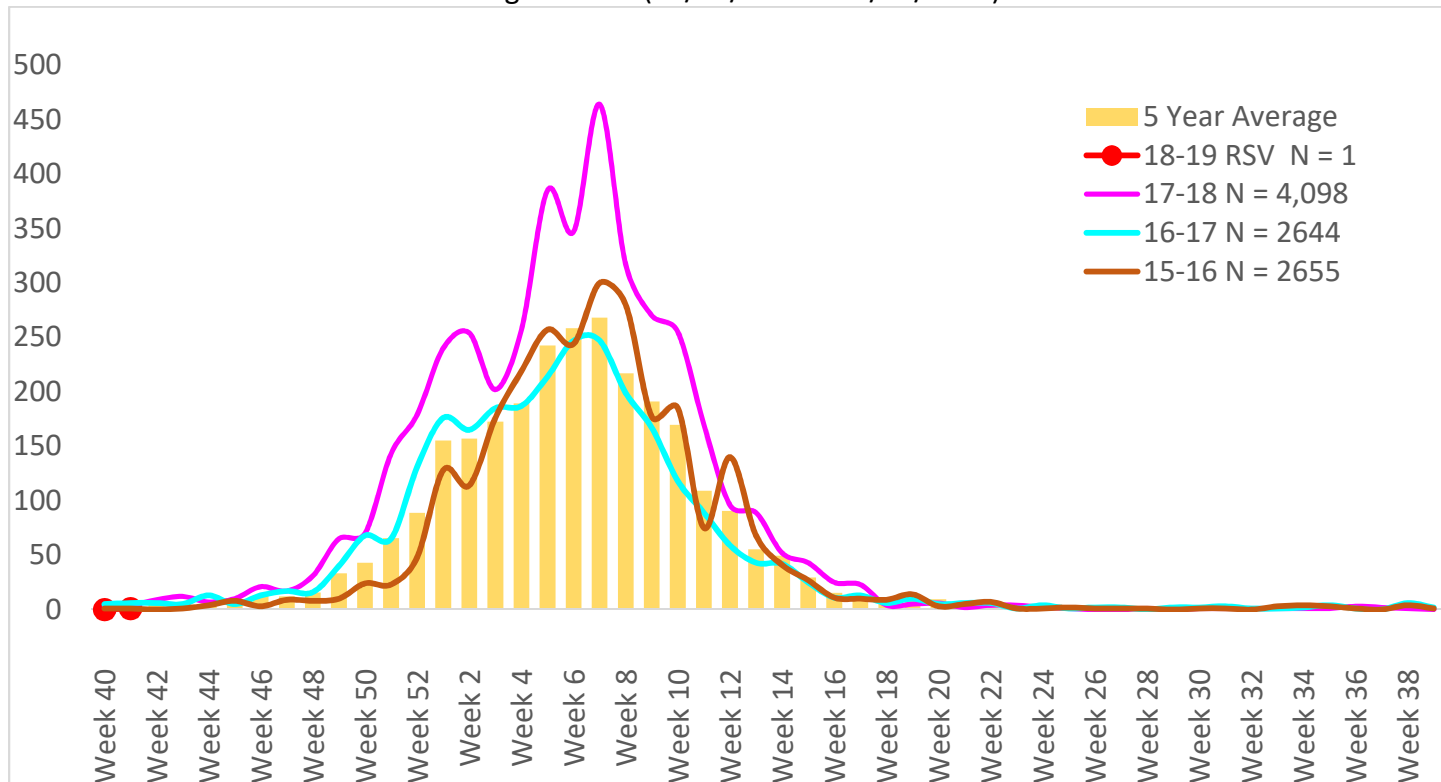

Weeks 40 and 41

Respiratory Syncytial Virus (RSV)

The 2018-2019 RSV season starts on 9/30/2018 (week 40 of 2018) and continues through 9/28/2019 (week 39 of 2019). Through week 41 (10/07/2018 – 10/13/2018), 1 RSV case has been laboratory confirmed in Maricopa County.

No cases of RSV were confirmed during week 40 (09/30/2018 – 10/06/2018).
