

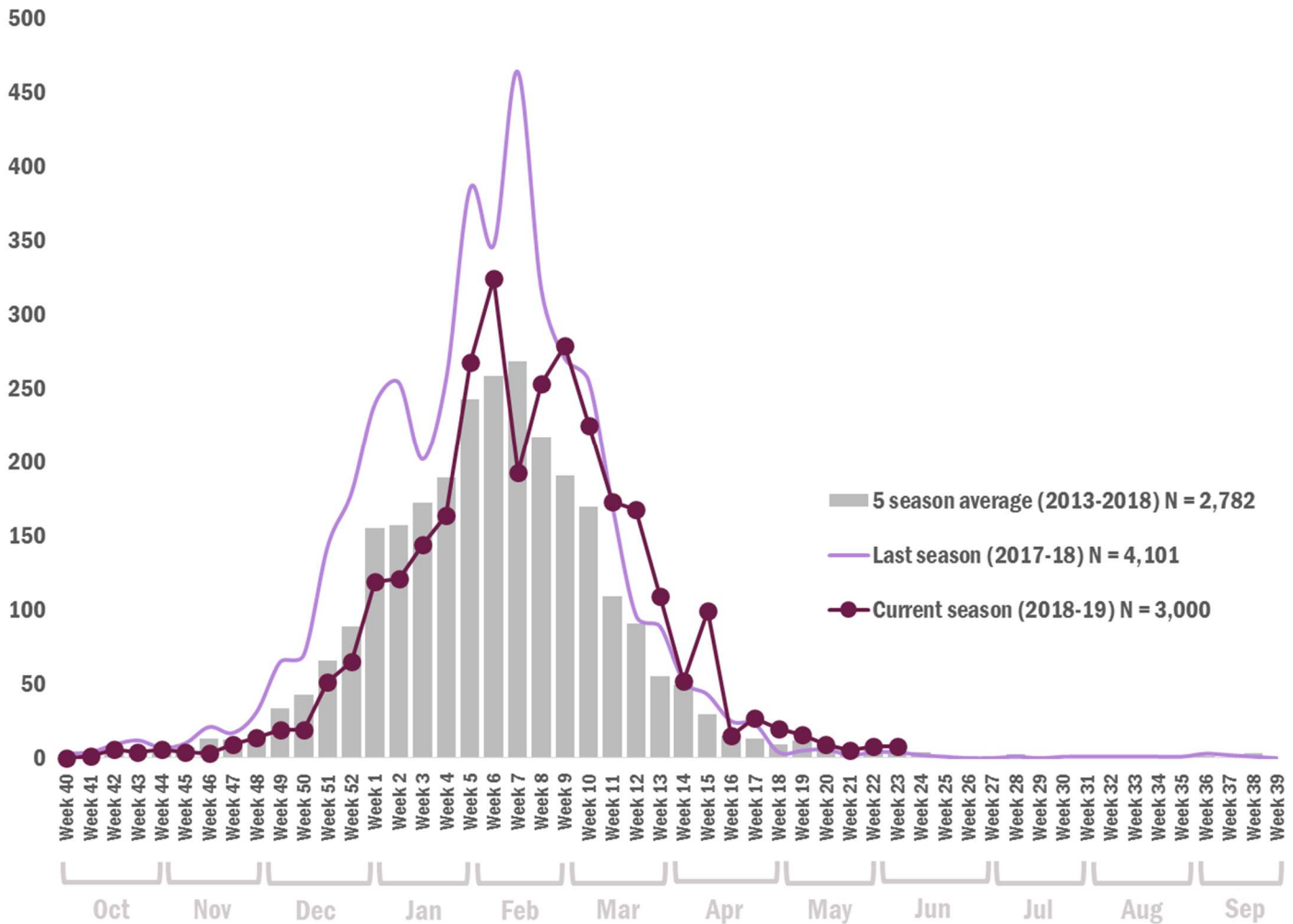
RESPIRATORY SYNCYTIAL VIRUS IN MARICOPA COUNTY

WEEKS 22 & 23 (May 26 – June 8, 2019)

All data are preliminary and may change as more reports are received.

The 2018-2019 Respiratory Syncytial Virus (RSV) season starts on 9/30/2018 (week 40 of 2018) and continues through 9/28/2019 (week 39 of 2019). Through **week 23** of 2019, **3,000** RSV cases have been laboratory confirmed in Maricopa County.
