

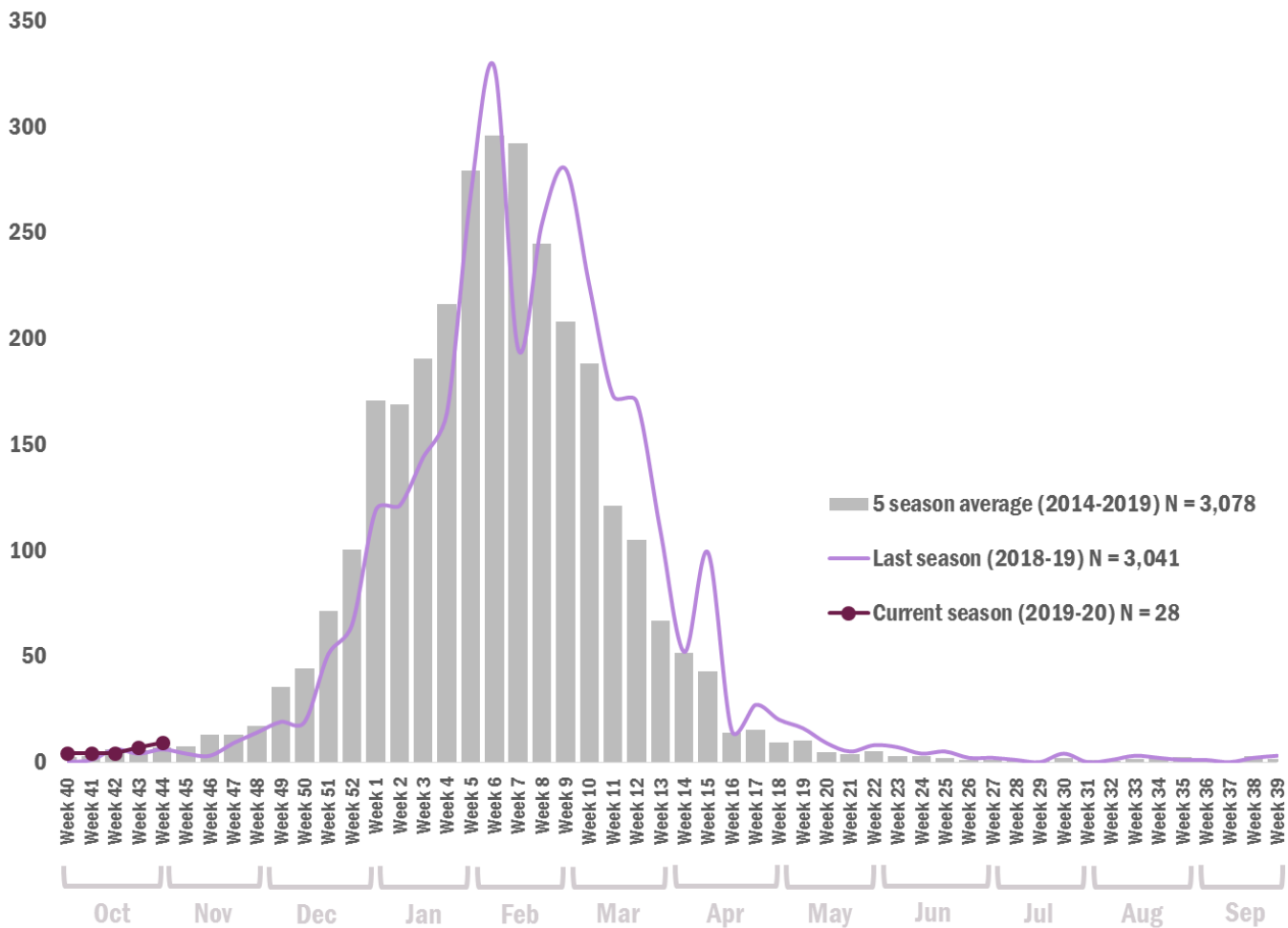
# RESPIRATORY SYNCYTIAL VIRUS IN MARICOPA COUNTY

## WEEK 44 (OCT 27 – NOV 2, 2019)

All data are preliminary and may change as more reports are received.

The 2019-2020 Respiratory Syncytial Virus (RSV) season starts on 9/29/2019 (week 40 of 2019) and continues through 9/26/2020 (week 39 of 2020). Through **week 44** of 2019, **28** RSV cases have been laboratory confirmed in Maricopa County.
