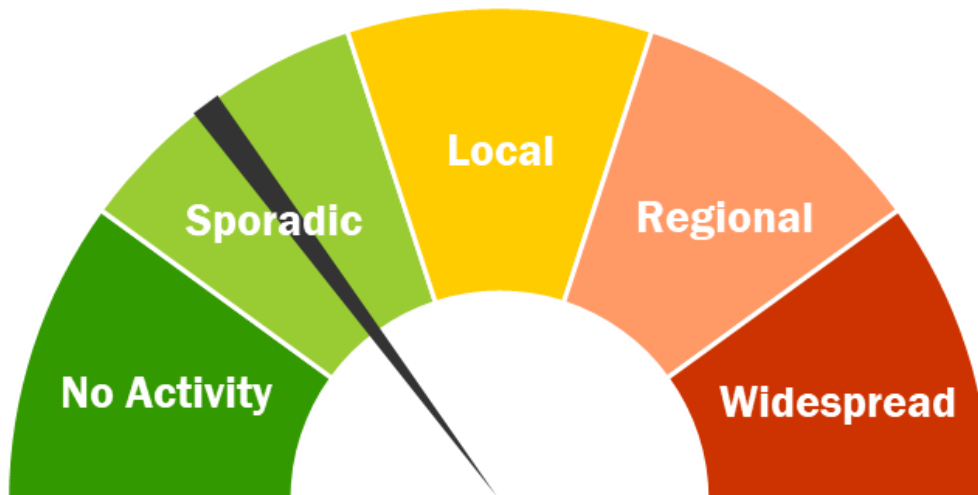


# INFLUENZA IN MARICOPA COUNTY

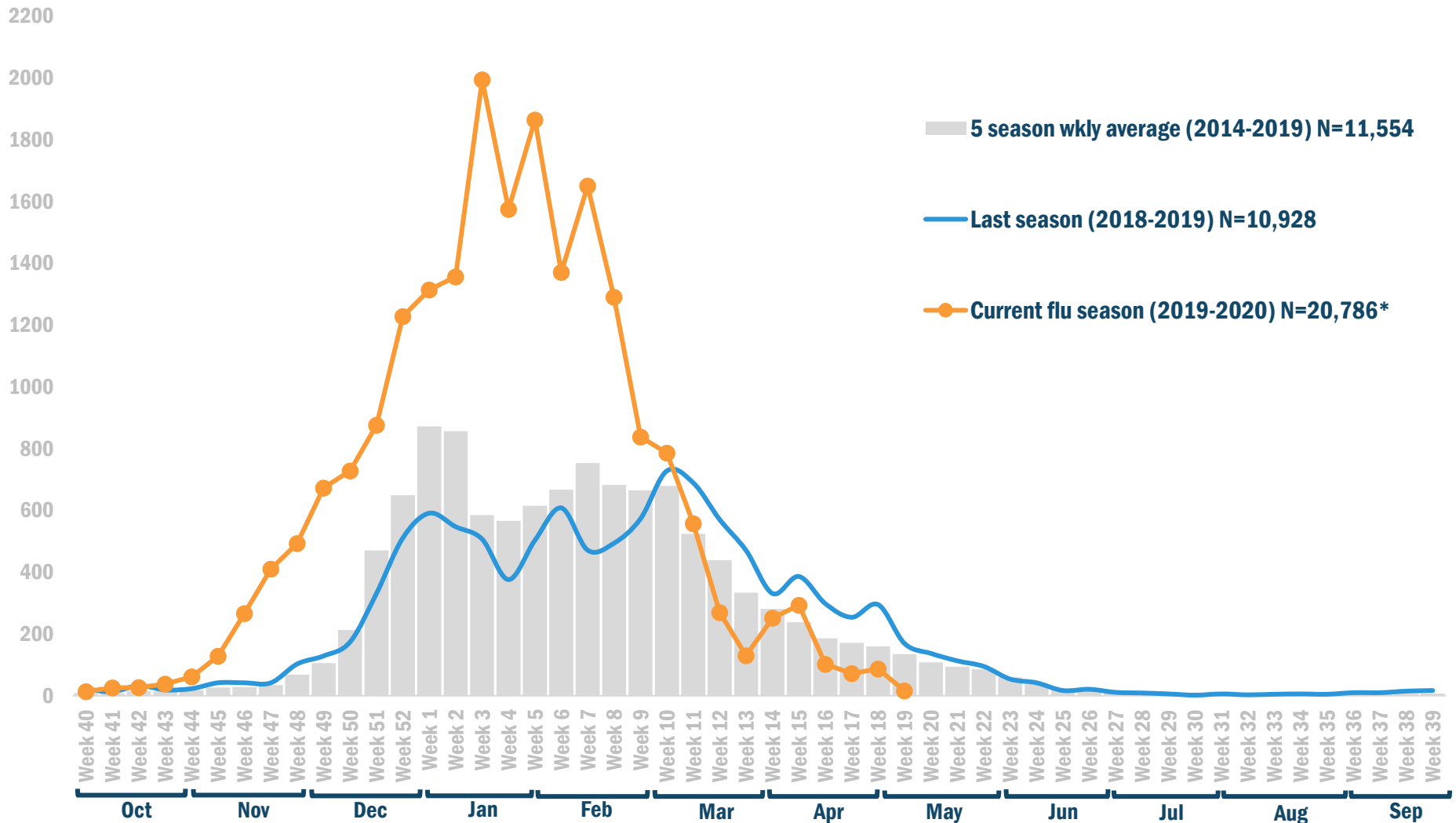

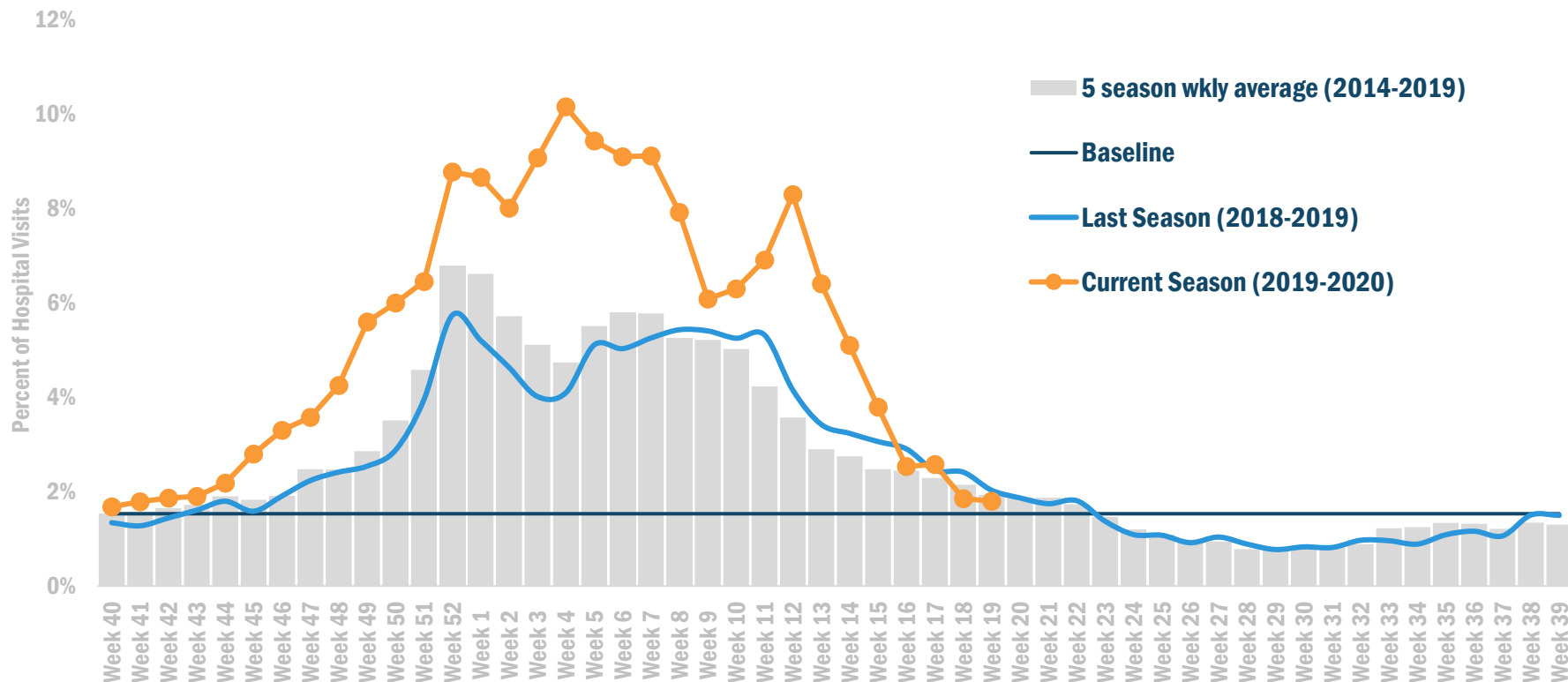

The graph below shows the percent of Inpatient and Emergency Department visits that are ILI-related from 34 hospitals across Maricopa County.
