

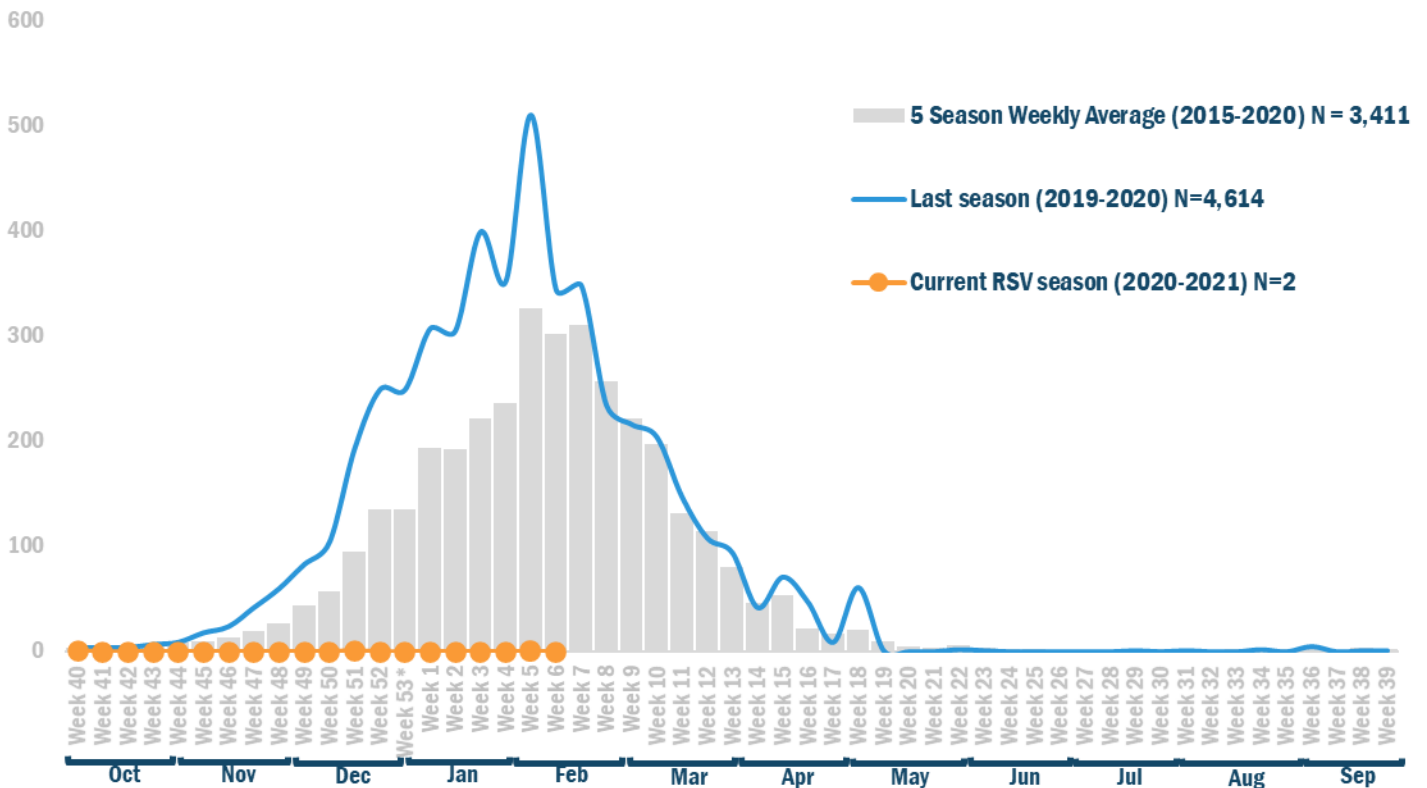
# RESPIRATORY SYNCYTIAL VIRUS IN MARICOPA COUNTY

## WEEK 6 (FEBRUARY 07, 2021 – FEBRUARY 13, 2021)

All data are preliminary and may change as more reports are received.

The 2020-2021 Respiratory Syncytial Virus (RSV) season starts on 9/27/2020 (week 40 of 2020) and continues through 10/2/2021 (week 39 of 2021). From week 40 of 2020 through **week 6** of 2021, **2** RSV cases have been laboratory confirmed in Maricopa County.

\*Because there was no week 53 during the previous 5 seasons, the current week's data are represented by week 52 data for all previous seasons.
