

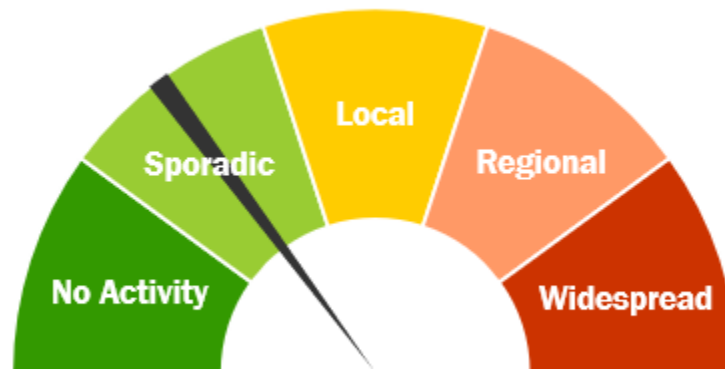
# INFLUENZA IN MARICOPA COUNTY

## WEEK 11 (MARCH 14, 2021 – MARCH 20, 2021)

All data are preliminary and may change as more reports are received.

The 2020-2021 Influenza (flu) season starts on 9/27/2020 (week 40 of 2020) and continues through 10/2/2021 (week 39 of 2021). From week 40 of 2020 through **week 11** of 2021, **688** flu cases have been laboratory confirmed in Maricopa County.

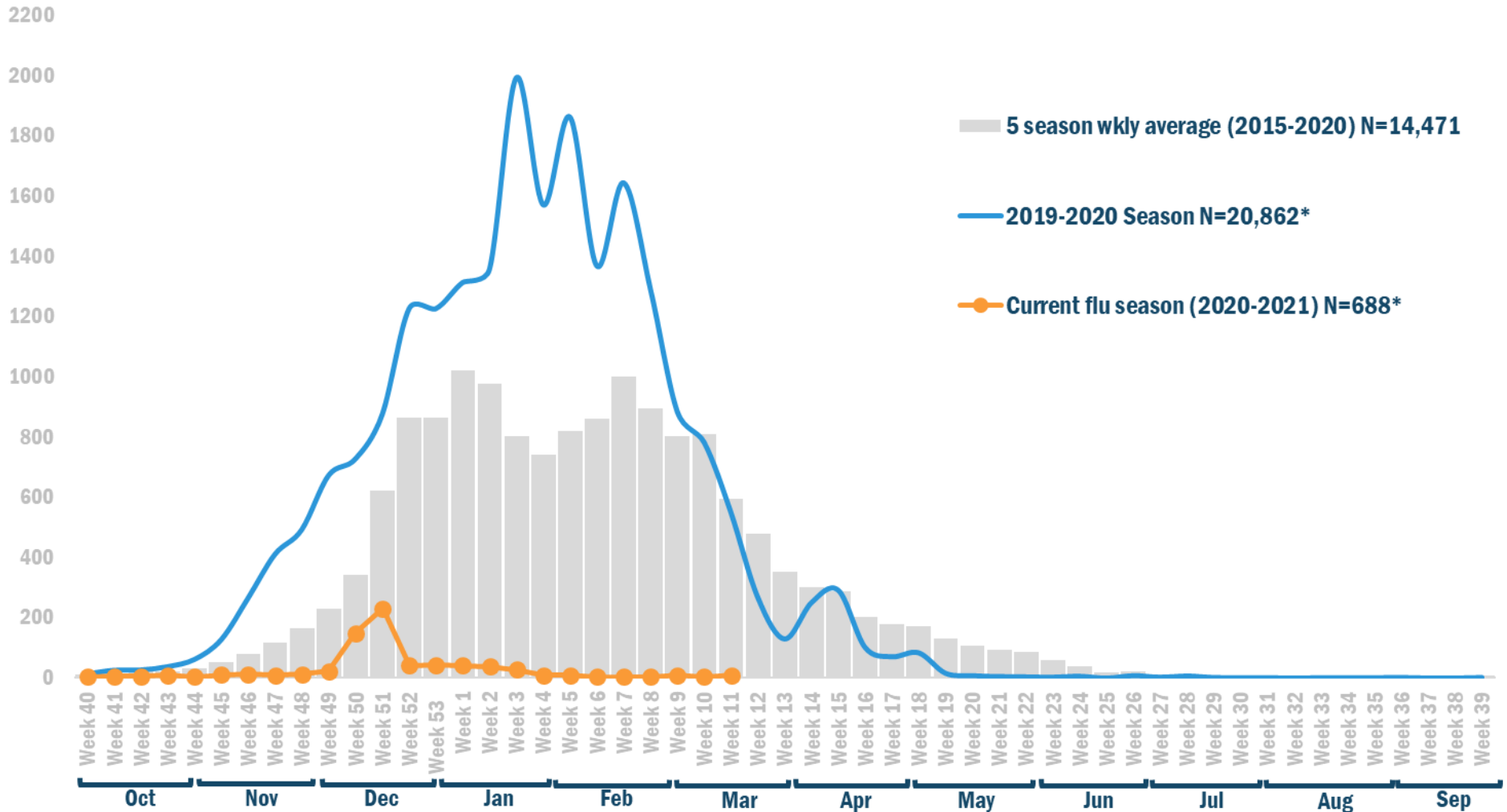

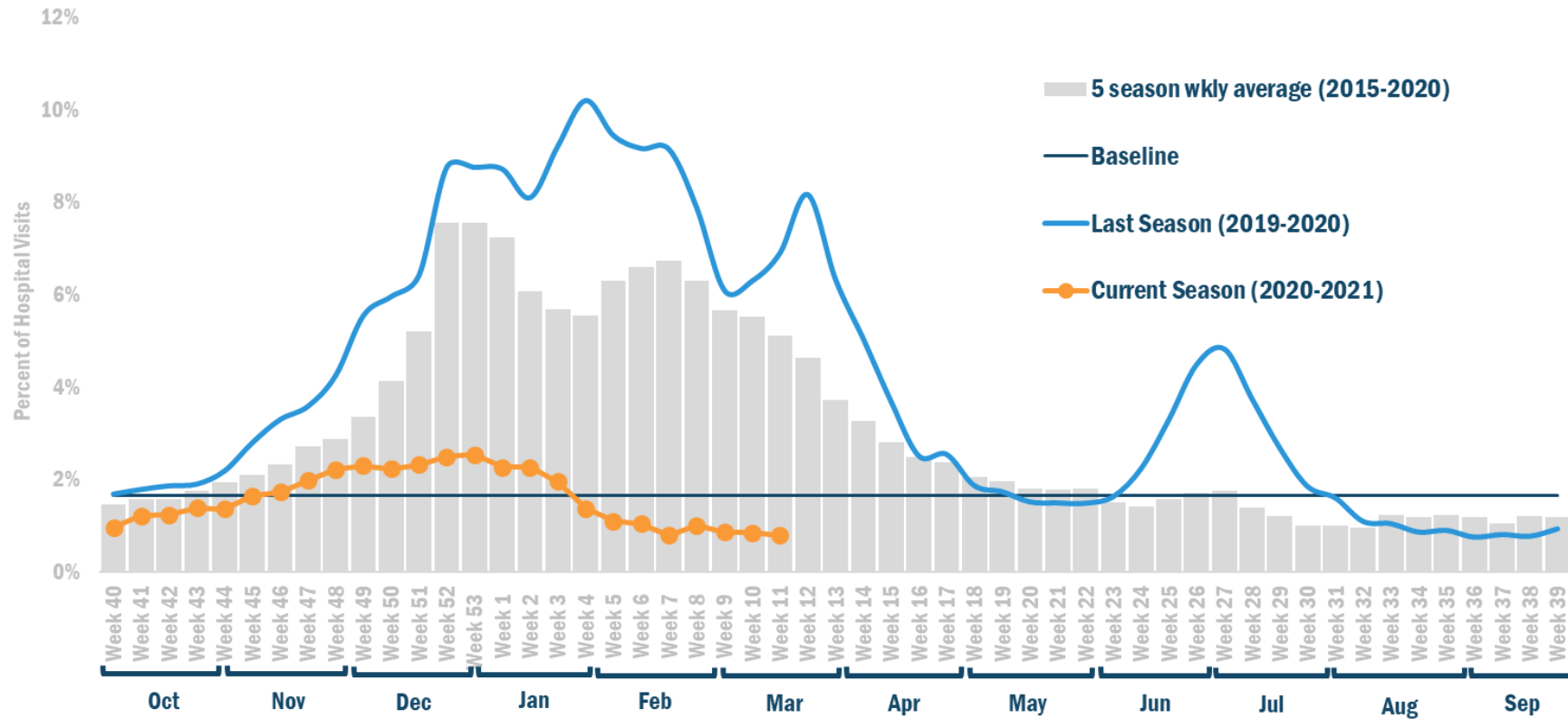
Because there was no week 53 during the previous 5 seasons, the current week's data are represented by week 52 data for all previous seasons.

Visits related to COVID-19 will be identified by the ILI symptom-based query because ILI and COVID-19 have similar clinical presentations.
