

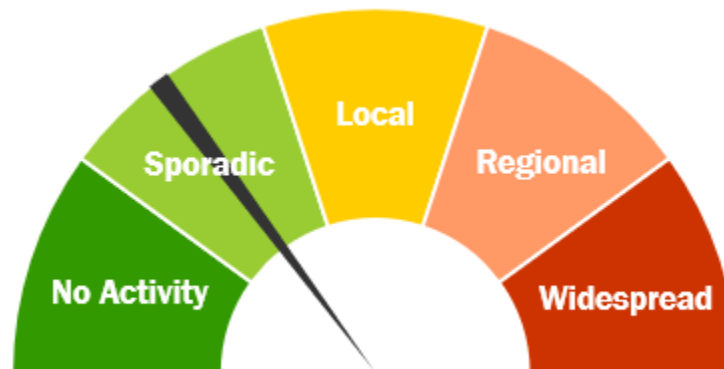
INFLUENZA IN MARICOPA COUNTY

WEEK 38 (SEPTEMBER 19, 2021 – SEPTEMBER 25, 2021)

All data are preliminary and may change as more reports are received.

The 2020-2021 Influenza (flu) season starts on 9/27/2020 (week 40 of 2020) and continues through 10/2/2021 (week 39 of 2021). From week 40 of 2020 through **week 38** of 2021, **819** flu cases have been laboratory confirmed in Maricopa County.

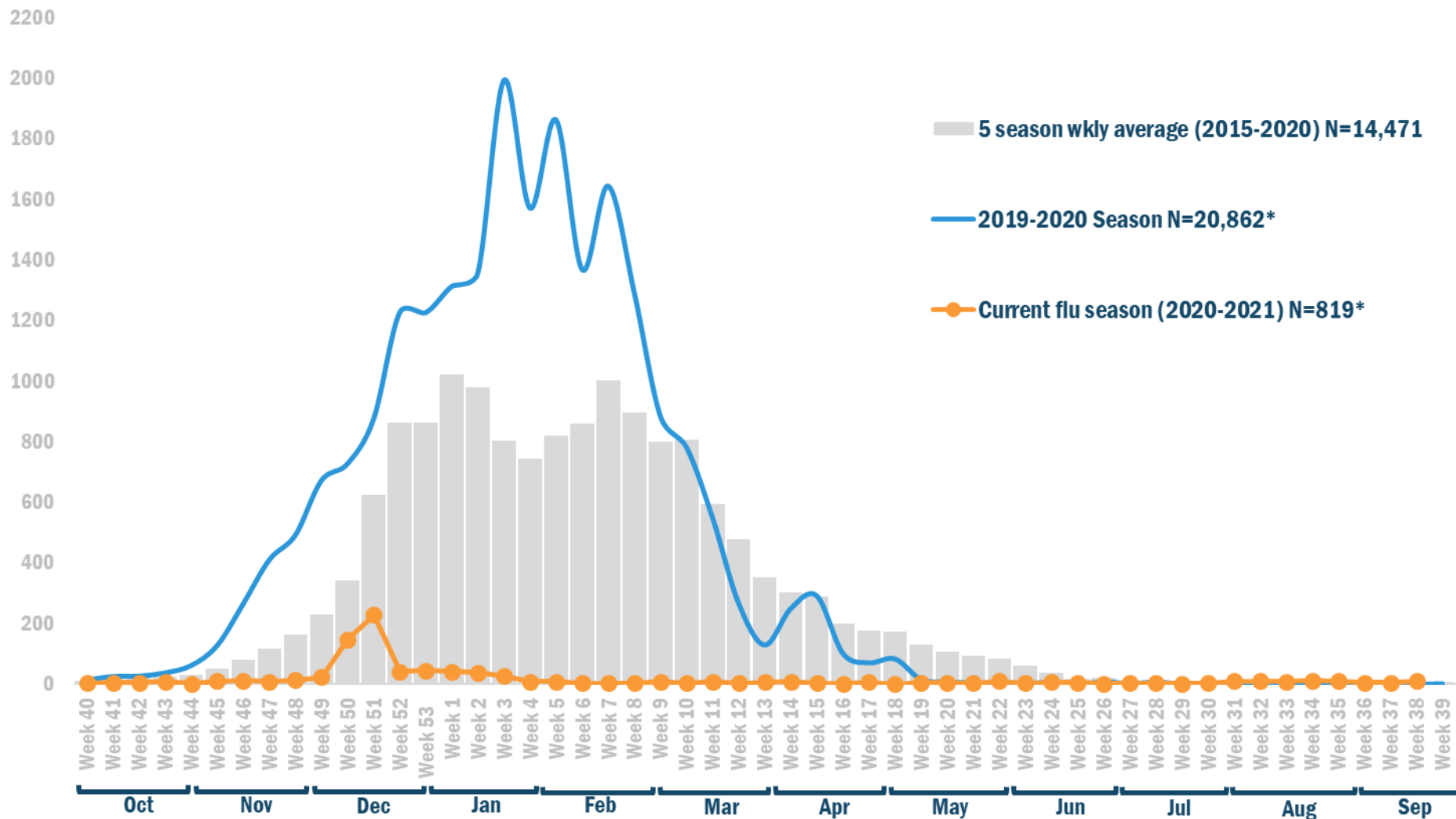

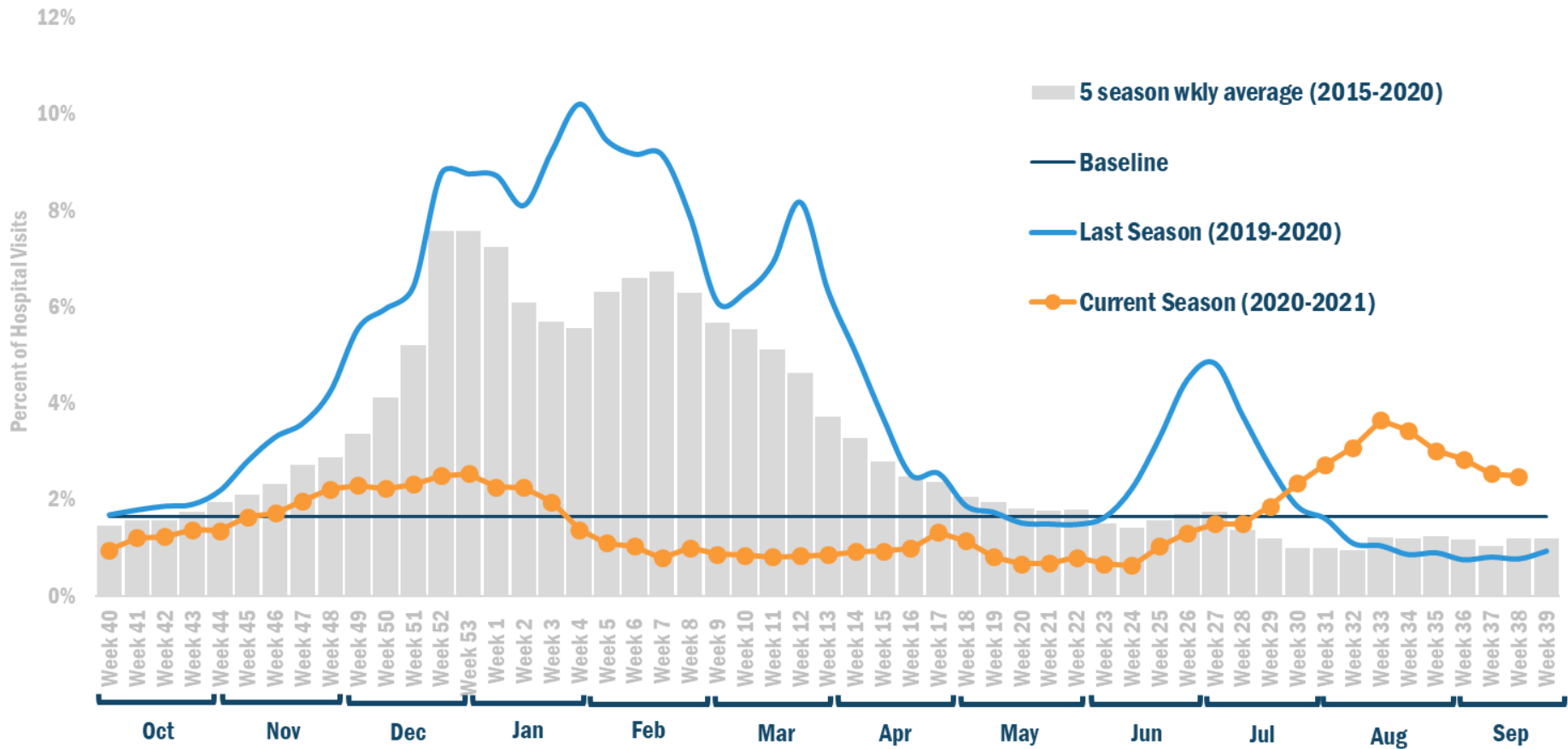
Because there was no week 53 during the previous 5 seasons, the current week's data are represented by week 52 data for all previous seasons.

WHAT DOES FLU LOOK LIKE IN MARICOPA COUNTY HOSPITALS?

The graph below shows the percent of Inpatient and Emergency Department visits that are ILI-related from 34 hospitals across Maricopa County.

Visits related to COVID-19 will be identified by the ILI symptom-based query because ILI and COVID-19 have similar clinical presentations.
