

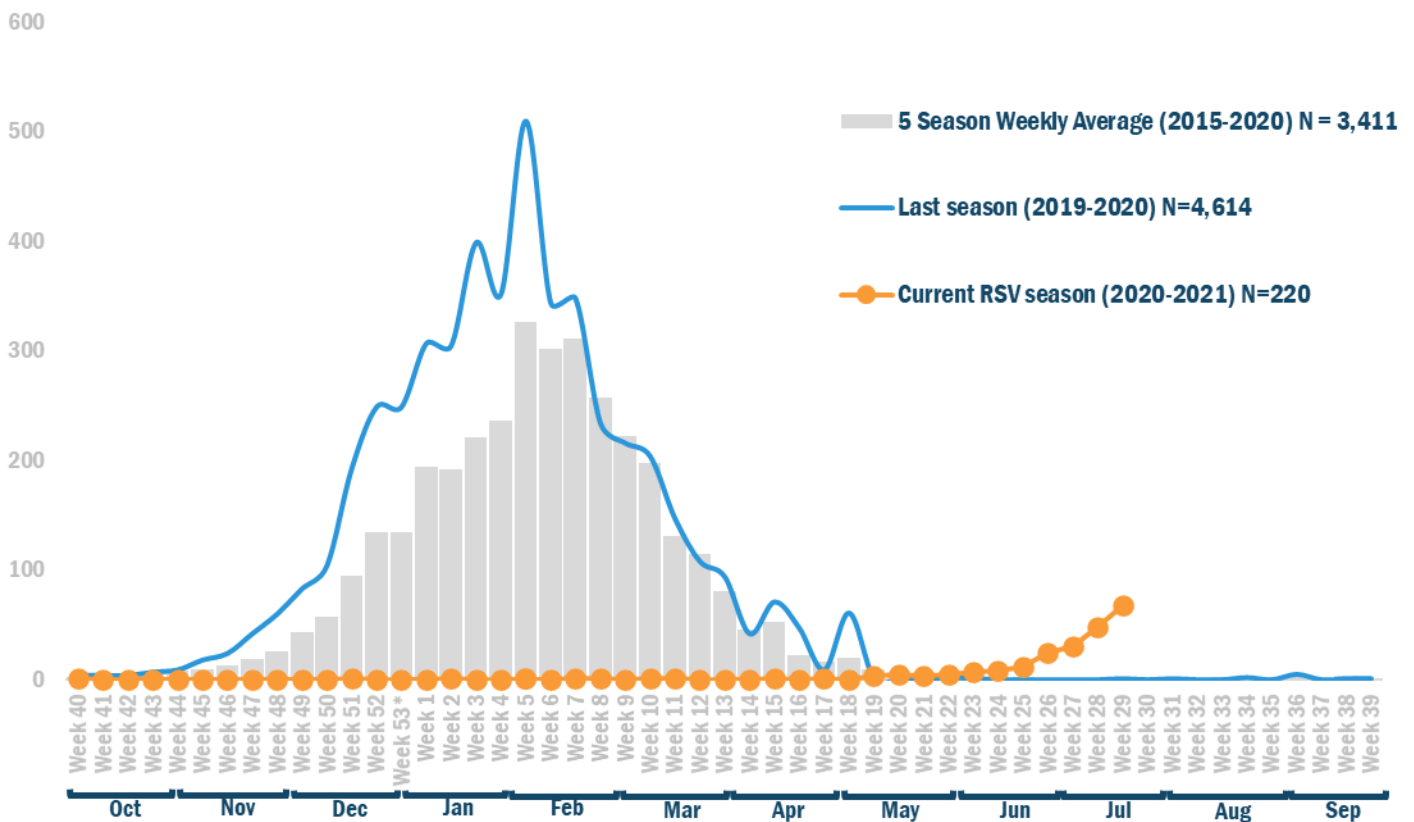
RESPIRATORY SYNCYTIAL VIRUS IN MARICOPA COUNTY

WEEK 29 (JULY 18, 2021 – JULY 24, 2021)

All data are preliminary and may change as more reports are received.

The 2020-2021 Respiratory Syncytial Virus (RSV) season starts on 9/27/2020 (week 40 of 2020) and continues through 10/2/2021 (week 39 of 2021). From week 40 of 2020 through **week 29** of 2021, **220** RSV cases have been laboratory confirmed in Maricopa County.
