

RESPIRATORY SYNCYTIAL VIRUS IN MARICOPA COUNTY


WEEK 8 (FEBRUARY 20, 2022 – FEBRUARY 26, 2022)

All data are preliminary and may change as more reports are received.

The 2021-2022 Respiratory Syncytial Virus (RSV) season started on 10/3/2021 (week 40 of 2021) and continues through 10/1/2022 (week 39 of 2022). From week 40 of 2021 through week 8 of 2022, 2,057 RSV cases have been laboratory confirmed in Maricopa County.
