## *CRIMINAL JUSTICE SYSTEM NEWS – February 2011*

### Adult Incarceration

**Bookings decreased** from 9,631 in January to 8,342 in February. The **Average Daily Population decreased slightly** from 7,050 in January to 7,048 in February. The **Pretrial Population decreased** in February (4,868) compared to January (4,895). The **Sentenced Population increased** from 1,859 in January to 1,888 in February. The **Agency Hold Population decreased** from 249 in January to 241 in February. **Overall Average Length of Stay (ALOS) decreased** from January (24.3) to February (23.7). **The ALOS for Sentenced decreased** from 24.1 to 23.5 days, while the **Pretrial ALOS decreased** from 6.3 to 5.7 days. The **ALOS for Agency Holds decreased** from 64.7 to 62.2 days.

### Superior Court Filings & Case Processing

**Criminal Filings decreased** from January (2,624) to February (2,519). **Terminations decreased** from 3,144 in January to 3,020 in February. The resulting **Clearance Rate** was 120%. The **Active Pending Case Inventory decreased** from 10,285 in January to 10,051 in February. **Filings into RCC decreased** in February (1,397) compared to January (1,464). **Filings into EDC increased** from 933 in January to 906 in February. The **Number of Trials Completed decreased** from 63 in January to 55 in February. The **Trial Rate** was 2.2%.

### Justice Court Filings

**DUI Filings decreased** from January (1,072) to February (598). All other **Criminal Traffic Filings decreased** from 3,814 in January to 3,304 in February. **Civil Traffic Filings decreased** from 10,995 in January to 9,148 in February. **Eviction Action Filings decreased** from January (5,579) to February (3,870). **Overall Filings decreased** from 31,876 in January to 26,744 in February.

### Adult Probation

**Pretrial General Supervision decreased** from January (594) to February (581). **Pretrial Intensive Supervision increased** from 856 in January to 945 in February. **Electronic Monitoring increased** from 180 in January to 203 in February. **Levels of Standard Probation Supervision decreased** from 30,213 in January to 30,111 in February. **Levels of Intensive Probation Supervision increased slightly** from 802 in January to 803 in February.






# Average Daily Jail Population




# Average Daily Jail Population by Type



# Overall Average Length of Stay in Jail




# Average Length of Stay in Jail for Agency Holds




# Average Length of Stay in Jail Pretrial vs Sentenced Population



# Average Length of Stay in Jail for Pretrial Inmates




# Sheriff's Office Transports for Inmate Court Appearances








# Active Pending Criminal Case Inventory

Cases Arraigned




# Direct Complaints into Superior Court




# Status of Cases After 180 Days


Average Monthly Dispositions by Quarter






# Grand Jury Indictments




## Average Monthly Filings by Quarter




# Pretrial Supervision Defendant Monitoring Unit



# Pretrial Supervision Defendants on Electronic Monitoring




# Adult Probation Standard Supervision Population



# Adult Probation Intensive Supervision Population




# Juvenile Detention Average Daily Population<sup>1</sup>

# Juvenile Detention Average Length of Stay<sup>1</sup>


