CRIMINAL JUSTICE SYSTEM NEWS – January 2009

Adult Incarceration

Bookings increased from 9,947 in December to 11,155 in January. The **Average Daily Population increased** from 9,223 to 9,376. The **Pretrial Population increased** in January (6,473) compared to December (6,390). The **Sentenced Population increased** to 2,151 in January compared to 2,106 in December. **Agency Hold Populations also increased** from 331 in December to 355 in January. **Overall Average Length of Stay (ALOS) decreased** in November from 27.7 days to 26.0 days. **The ALOS for Sentenced decreased** from 25.1 to 23.8; while the **ALOS for Agency Holds increased** from 57.4 to 66.0. **Pretrial ALOS decreased** from 7.0 to 6.5.

Superior Court Filings & Case Processing

Criminal filings decreased from December (3,237) to January (2,854). **Terminations increased** to 3,278 in January from 3,154 in December. The resulting **Clearance Rate** was 114.9%. **The Active Pending Case Inventory decreased** from 12,024 in December to 11,816 in January. **Filings into RCC decreased** in January (1,737) compared to December (2,021). **Filings into EDC decreased** from 992 in December to 902 in January. **The Number of Trials Completed increased** from 58 in December to 82 in January. **The Trial Rate** was 2.9%.

Justice Court Filings

Forcible Detainer Filings decreased from December (6,308) to January (5,958). **Overall Filings decreased** from December (38,766) to January (38,013).


Adult Probation

Pretrial General Supervision decreased from December (679) to January (628); **Pretrial Intensive Supervision decreased**, from 1,114 in December to 1,099 in January. **Electronic Monitoring remained** 263. Levels of **Standard Probation Supervision increased slightly** from (30,108) in December to (30,167) in January; **Levels of Intensive Probation Supervision increased slightly** from 994 in December to 996 in January.


Juvenile Detention and Probation

The **Average Daily Detention Population (ADP) increased** from 231 in December to 248 in January. ADP is down 22% when comparing FY08 to FY09. **ALOS decreased** from 14.6 days to 13.0 days. ALOS is down 21% when comparing FY08 to FY09. **Commitments to ADJC decreased** from 31 in December to 24 in January. **Standard probation increased** from 4,294 in December to 4,461 in January. **Intensive Probation decreased slightly** from 471 to 461.


Jail Bookings




Average Daily Jail Population




Average Daily Jail Population by Type



Overall Average Length of Stay in Jail




Average Length of Stay in Jail for Agency Holds




Average Length of Stay in Jail Pretrial vs Sentenced Population



Average Length of Stay in Jail for Pretrial Inmates




Sheriff's Office Transports for Inmate Court Appearances





Direct Complaints into Superior Court




Grand Jury Indictments




Superior Court Trials Completed



Active Pending Criminal Case Inventory





Pretrial Supervision Defendant Monitoring Unit




Pretrial Supervision Defendants on Electronic Monitoring




Disposition of Cases Terminated


Average monthly dispositions by quarter



Status of Cases After 180 Days




Adult Probation Standard Supervision Population



Adult Probation Intensive Supervision Population




Juvenile Detention Average Daily Population


Juvenile Detention Average Length of Stay
