### *CRIMINAL JUSTICE SYSTEM NEWS – May 2011*

#### Adult Incarceration

**Bookings increased** from 9,173 in April to 9,305 in May. The **Average Daily Population increased** from 7,416 in April to 7,426 in May. The **Pretrial Population increased** in May (5,095) compared to April (5,061). The **Sentenced Population decreased** from 1,975 in April to 1,947 in May. The **Agency Hold Population increased** from 327 in April to 330 in May. **Overall Average Length of Stay (ALOS) increased** from April (24.3) to May (25.7). **The ALOS for Sentenced decreased** from 24.8 to 24.1 days, while the **Pretrial ALOS increased** from 6.4 to 6.9 days. The **ALOS for Agency Holds increased** from 63 to 68 days.

#### Superior Court Filings & Case Processing

**Criminal Filings decreased** from April (2,962) to May (2,617). **Terminations decreased** from 3,359 in April to 2,963 in May. The resulting **Clearance Rate** was 113%. The **Active Pending Case Inventory decreased** from 10,284 in April to 10,147 in May. **Filings into RCC decreased slightly** in May (1,566) compared to April (1,567). **Filings into EDC decreased** from 1,127 in April to 833 in May. The **Number of Trials Completed decreased** from 58 in April to 31 in May. **The Trial Rate** was 1.2%.

#### Justice Court Filings

**DUI Filings increased** from April (730) to May (829). All other **Criminal Traffic Filings decreased** from 3,722 in April to 3,568 in May. **Civil Traffic Filings decreased** from 11,841 in April to 10,647 in May. **Eviction Action Filings increased** from April (4,801) to May (5,302). **Overall Filings decreased** from 31,840 in April to 31,463 in May.

#### Adult Probation

**Pretrial General Supervision increased** from April (554) to May (576). **Pretrial Intensive Supervision increased** from 1,022 in April to 1,081 in May. **Electronic Monitoring decreased** from 218 in April to 206 in May. **Levels of Standard Probation Supervision decreased** from 30,005 in April to 29,987 in May. **Levels of Intensive Probation Supervision increased** from 796 in April to 811 in May.


#### Juvenile Detention and Probation

The **Average Daily Detention Population decreased** from 257 in April to 251 in May. **ALOS increased** from 14.2 to 14.7 days. **Standard probation decreased** from 3,349 in April to 3,267 in May. **Intensive Probation decreased** from 316 in April to 304 in May.




# Jail Bookings




# Average Daily Jail Population




# Average Daily Jail Population by Type



# Overall Average Length of Stay in Jail




# Average Length of Stay in Jail for Agency Holds




# Average Length of Stay in Jail Pretrial vs Sentenced Population



# Average Length of Stay in Jail for Pretrial Inmates




# Sheriff's Office Transports for Inmate Court Appearances








# Active Pending Criminal Case Inventory

■ Cases Arraigned




# Direct Complaints into Superior Court




# Status of Cases After 180 Days


Average Monthly Dispositions by Quarter






# Grand Jury Indictments




## Average Monthly Filings by Quarter




# Pretrial Supervision Defendant Monitoring Unit



# Pretrial Supervision Defendants on Electronic Monitoring




# Adult Probation Standard Supervision Population




# Adult Probation Intensive Supervision Population



# Juvenile Detention Average Daily Population




# Juvenile Detention Average Length of Stay
