- All Scripts Professional
 - Stand alone, \$340 one-time set up fee, \$150 per year per prescriber
- Dose Spot
 - Stand alone: \$499 per year per prescriber
- Dr.First/iPrescribe
 - \$90 one-time set up fee, \$75 per year per prescriber
- Eaglesoft/Patterson
 - Integrated into the software. Contact Patterson for support
- Henry Schein
 - Integration with Dentrix or Easy Dental: \$150 one-time set up fee, \$35 per month per prescriber
 - OMSVision, PerioVision, EndoVision, DentalVision – web-based that is integrated with software, call for demo and information
 - Dentrix Ascend – use DoseSpot
 - Viive – use Allscripts online
- LexiComp
 - Stand alone: 3 options starting at \$499 per year per prescriber
- MD ToolBox
 - Free 30 day trial, then a monthly plan.
- NewCrop
 - \$150 one-time set up fee, \$150 per year per prescriber
- RxNT
 - \$650 per year with unlimited prescribers
- Treat
 - Stand alone, check website for info



How To E-Prescribe

The AZ State Mandate for E-Prescriptions takes effect January 2020...

(Setting up can take 30 days or longer)

Getting Started:

1. Select the software
 - a. Software is sold with or without EPCS procedures
 - b. Software with EPCS costs more due to the cost of compliance
2. Follow the software vendor's instructions to complete identity proofing
 - a. Submit dental license
 - b. DEA registration
 - c. NPI Type 1 numbers
 - d. Answer a series of questions
3. Once identity is proved, you will receive credentials to sign an EPCS
 - a. If you work at multiple locations this may need to be done at each location
4. DEA requires two-factor authentication for signing EPCS
 - a. Something you know (password)
 - b. Something you have (hard token, fob, cell phone)
 - c. Something you are (fingerprint)
5. Giving any of the factors to another individual can lead to revocation or suspension of prescriber's DEA registration
 - a. Staff may enter information, but only the prescriber may "sign" and submit
6. Access controls requires two people, one prescriber, one administrator
 - a. Admin ensures credentials are current, reports security incidents to software vendor and DEA
