### Early Education



#### Providing Quality Early Education

- **\$221,000** was spent on children enrolled in early education and child care programs



### Workforce Development



#### Creating Career Growth Opportunities

- **440** adults and **69** youth received career services
- **65** residents received skills training in growing industries
- **119** residents participated in construction apprenticeships
- **73%** of participants earned an educational or industry-recognized credential
- **\$14.60** is the median hourly wage of residents that received individualized services



### Shelter for the Homeless



#### Identifying Emergency Shelter for the Homeless

- **\$143,000** was provided to District 3 partners for emergency shelter



### Utility & Rental Assistance



#### Reducing Financial Burdens

- **64** households received utility and/or rental assistance
- **70%** of households served live at or below 100% FPL\*
- **\$643** is the average utility payment provided to households in District 3
- **\$1,511** is the average amount of rental assistance provided to District 3 households



### Senior Case Management



#### Providing Person-Centered Case Management

- **72%** of residents served live at or below 150% FPL\*
- **105** residents served are between the ages of 18-59 and live with a physical disability
- **67%** of residents served are 70+ years of age
- **728** residents were connected to home-delivered meals
- **43%** of residents served have lived independently in their home for 2+ years due to services received
