

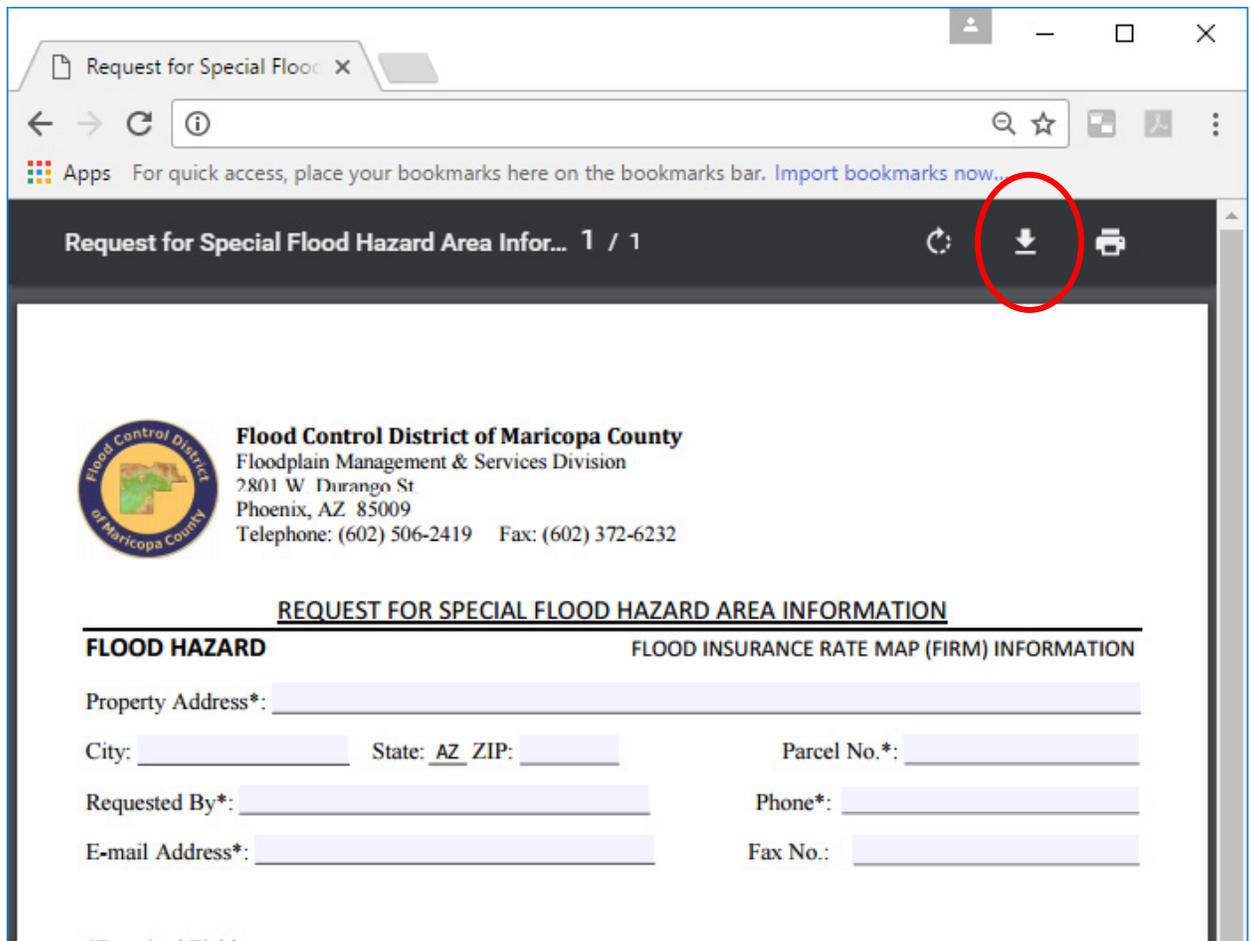
Chrome Users:

The Google Chrome browser has a built-in default PDF reader, which is fine for viewing PDFs but does not work well for PDF forms.

One of the issues that we are noticing is that while Chrome does allow for interactivity, such as allowing the user to fill out form fields, it does not process things like submit buttons. Another issue is that it does not put any form inputs into memory, so if you view the form in the browser, and fill it out, you CANNOT then download the form with the data you input.

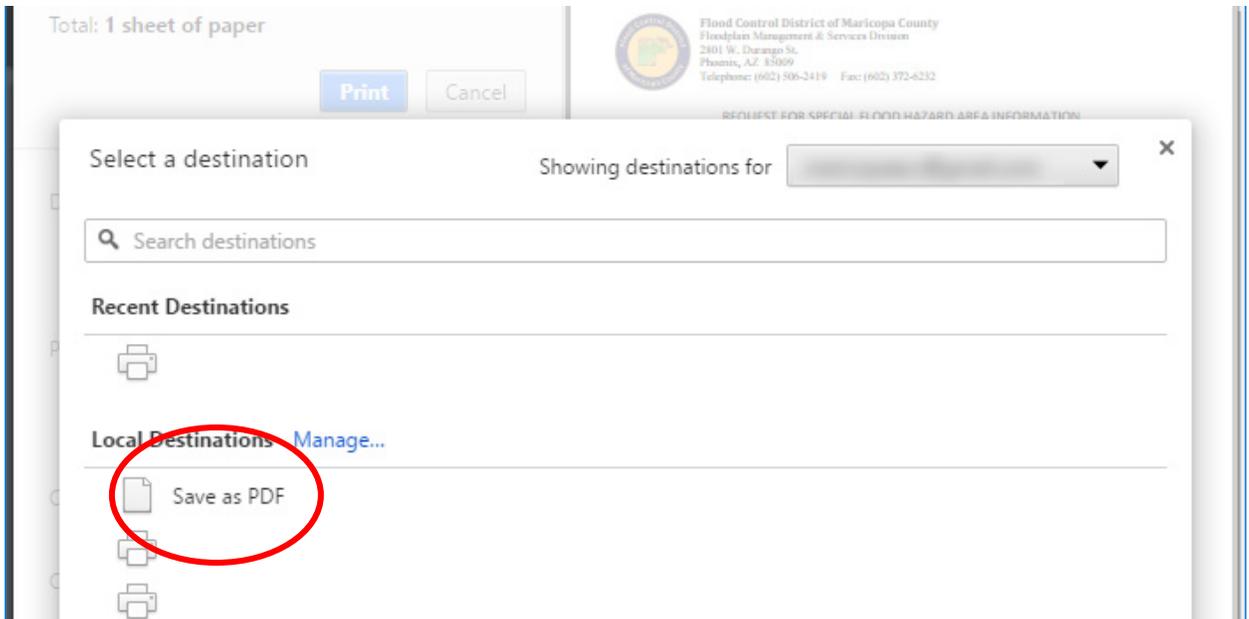
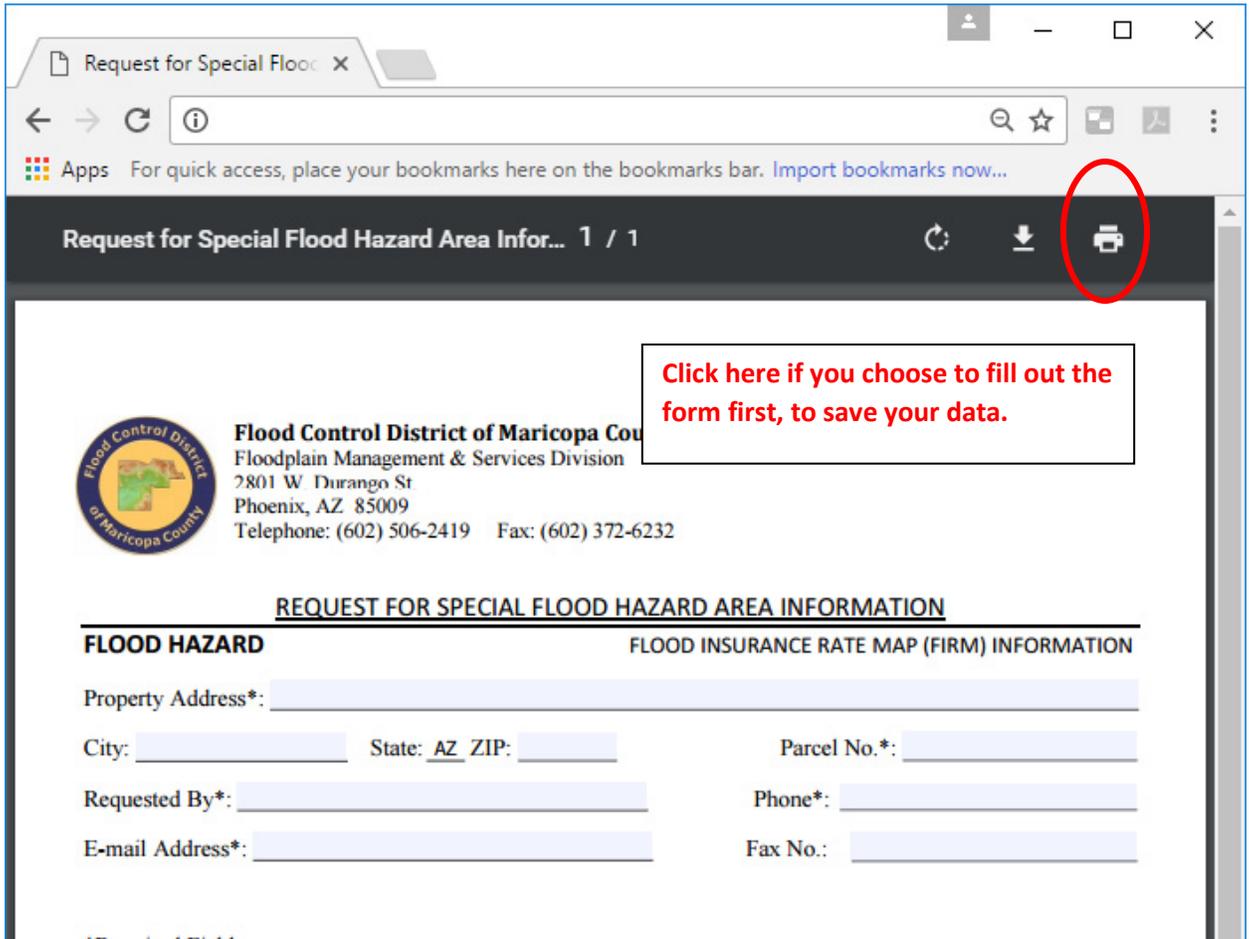
To email us the form you will either have to:

1. download the form first, via the button at the top, and then open it in a separate application, such as Adobe Reader or Foxit. Then fill out form, save it normally, and then send it to forminfo@mail.maricopa.gov. -- See below --



After opening the file in the browser, immediately click the download button at the top of the window.

- Alternatively, you can fill the form out in the browser, and then select the print button to “Save as PDF”. Then email the saved file to us.
