Surgery - Canine Ovariohysterectomy (Spay), performed by [REDACTED]

Ventral midline abdominal incision made with no. 15 blade. Single ligation of ovarian pedicles and double ligation of uterine stump with strangle knots using 0 Webmax. Modified 3-layer closure: Body wall closed with cruciate sutures using 0 Webmax; SQ layer closed with simple continuous sutures, continuing into continuous intradermal using 0 Webmax. Green tattoo etched. Applied tissue adhesive over abdominal incision and tattoo.

Rx and/or Post-op recommendations: Recommend follow up with primary veterinarian regarding overall health, baseline bloodwork, and preventative care.

Once out she seemed very upbeat and excited to be walking (almost skipping). She did have some starting and stopping on the walk. She did not seek or express affection very much, we tried stopping for pets etc. She allowed me to pet and handle her but she did not make eye contact. She was eager to get back to her walk. We had to again pass the dogs getting back to her kennel she had the freezing up and also returned a bark, but she was easily pushed along back into her kennel. She seemed like she much enjoyed the quiet and walking the most.

Set up activity for an Animal Control Officer to go collect the dog. She will call her doctor after we pick up the dog

[REDACTED] was informed of the quarantine process and the possibilities that can come of it. [REDACTED] stated her dog was checked out by a vet where she as prescribed antibiotics for her dog and was told to bring her dog in for bloodwork. After having no further questions, dog was impounded for quarantine.
