Eval date 10/05/2022 Eval type INTAKE ASSESSMENT

brought onto ramp on snare, stiff body, low to ground, tail tucked, vaccinated with snare, restraint, walked to kennel in bucket

Eval date 10/09/2022 Eval type EVALUATION

Locked to inside portion of kennel on handler approach. Ate hot dog treats that were tossed into the kennel. Came forward and took treats from handler. Handler opened kennel door and presented leash, dog retreated to the back corner and laid on the ground. Froze for leash placement. Once leash was placed dog froze. Handler presented leash at the front of the kennel, used minimal leash pressure and dog entered bucket willingly. Rode in bucket to play yard. Explored play yard and stayed close to kennel mate. After some time she began to come close to handler. Sat behind handler. Allowed light petting on the head and body when going slow. Not interested in walking on leash. Handler tipped bucket over and dog entered willingly. Rode in bucket back to kennel. Easy kennel return.

Eval date 10/16/2022 Eval type WALK

M&G, closed guillotine to leash, pulled back a little waalking out of wing, tail tucked walking to yard, immediately ran up to PA's and rested her head on the PA's lap. stayed there the entire meet and greet, tail tuck walking back, easy return.

Eval date 10/19/2022 Eval type WALK

Dog was laying inside when handler approached; came forward for tossed treats; retreated back inside kennel when handler presented leash; would come forward again but backed away each time leash was presented; handler stepped inside kennel and was able to lasso dog; dog walked out of kennel slowly; slow loose leash walked down wing; appeared nervous of barking dogs; tail tucked. Walked close to handler out to yard; explored yard; tail remained tucked; ignored offered treats; approached handler and allowed light petting on chest; sat down next to handler; allowed further light petting on head; appeared to relax over time; open mouth; tail in a neutral down position; ate offered treats gently; stayed near handler and allowed more petting on back. Walked close to handler on the way back to kennel; would lean against handler's leg while walking; entered kennel and allowed leash removal without issue.
