As stated in the Maricopa County Environmental Health Code, Ch. 1 Reg. 5a(2) “A waiver of fees to a current student, enrolled in a K-12 culinary arts school program or other similar curriculum based programs requiring a food service worker card from their students to be in compliance with this code. The sponsoring school district must demonstrate to the Board of Health that payment of said fee will cause financial hardship.”

Fee waiver applications are presented to the Board of Health by the Maricopa County Environmental Services Department (MCESD) for processing.
