With nearly **4 million people** in Maricopa County, a large-scale emergency such as a **disease outbreak**, **anthrax attack** or a **natural disaster** would require a community response.

A trained volunteer force will make all the difference.

Volunteers will be needed for a variety of tasks, such as:

- Trainings and exercises
- Setting up and staffing Points of Dispensing (PODs)
- Staffing call centers and Volunteer Reception Centers (VRCs)
- Working as an interpreter
- Providing public health response support
