Driving will only occur from 10am-12pm



- ✓ Maricopa County Department of Public Health's Office of Preparedness and Response, Paradise Valley Unified School District and North Canyon High School are hosting a POD Drive Through Exercise on April 14, 2012 at North Canyon High School, 1700 East Union Hills Drive
- ✓ This full-scale emergency preparedness exercise will test the strength and completeness of County and City plans during a simulated Anthrax attack.
- ✓ Pre-registered volunteers will drive their cars through the site as simulated medications are dispensed. We anticipate each driver will make several trips through the dispensing lines in order to simulate the crowds that would be anticipated in a real event. Volunteers will be offered lunch and a gas gift card
- ✓ Because trained community volunteers across Maricopa County are key to response success, OPR will be hosting POD Leadership Training for interested community volunteers. **You do not need to attend training to participate in the exercise!**
- ✓ Will include an orientation before the exercise, and a debriefing at the end of the exercise.
