The Maricopa County Board of Health will host a Public Meeting to discuss proposed revisions to the Maricopa County Air Pollution Control Regulations. The subject matter to be discussed includes:

Case #/Title: AQ-2013-005-New Source Review (NSR)

Overview: The purpose of this rulemaking is to update the Maricopa County Air Quality Department's NSR rules in order to comply with revisions that the Arizona Department of Environmental Quality (ADEQ) and the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) made to the NSR Pre-Construction Permitting Program under the federal Clean Air Act. NSR is a pre-construction permitting program that requires stationary sources of air pollution to get air quality permits before they start construction or make major modifications. If a source proposes to either build a new facility or make any modifications to existing facilities that would create a significant increase in emissions of a regulated pollutant, the source must undergo pre-construction review for air pollution controls, before it is issued an air quality permit.
