The Maricopa County Board of Health will host a public meeting to discuss recommendations to be made to the Maricopa County Board of Supervisors regarding revisions to the Maricopa County Air Pollution Control Regulations. The subject matter to be discussed includes:

**Case #/Title:** AQ-2013-005-New Source Review (NSR)

**Overview:** The purpose of this rulemaking is to update the department's NSR rules in order to secure their approval as part of the state implementation plan (SIP) under the federal Clean Air Act. The update will be consistent with revisions the Arizona Department of Environmental Quality (ADEQ) and the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) made to the NSR Program required by the federal Clean Air Act (CAA). The proposed amendments included in the rulemaking consist of extensive revisions to the county's major NSR program as well as new NSR requirements for minor sources and minor modifications designed to protect the national ambient air quality standards (NAAQS). (Whether a source or modification is major or minor depends on the level of emissions.) In addition, there is currently a significant discrepancy, known as the "SIP gap," between the NSR rules as set forth in the Maricopa County Air Pollution Control Regulations and the rules that have been approved by the EPA into the Maricopa County portion of the Arizona SIP. Once approved, the amended rules will eliminate the SIP gap. This rulemaking also includes proposed conforming and technical changes to rules related to NSR, such as requirements for the general permit program.
