The Maricopa County Board of Supervisors is scheduled to conduct a public hearing to solicit comments on proposed amendments to the Maricopa County Air Pollution Control Regulations Rule 241 (Minor New Source Review (NSR)) as described below and on submitting the rule as a revision to the (Arizona) State Implementation Plan (SIP). Following the public hearing, the Board of Supervisors is requested to adopt the proposed amendments to Rule 241 and to submit the amended rule as a revision to the (Arizona) SIP.

AQ-2016-002-Rule 241 (Minor New Source Review (NSR)): Rule 241 provides a procedure for the review of new sources and modifications to existing sources of air pollution requiring permits or permit revisions for the protection of the national ambient air quality standards (NAAQS). Revisions proposed in Rule 241 include changing the threshold when new or modified stationary sources are required to apply Best Available Control Technology (BACT) and Reasonably Available Control Technology (RACT) from 25 tons per year to 40 tons per year for volatile organic compounds, nitrogen oxides, or sulfur dioxide. Stakeholders have requested that Rule 241 be revised to be consistent with the federal thresholds.
