



HOME SCHOOL FILING PROCESS



A proper affidavit should include:

- ✓ A notarized signature
- ✓ Legal guardian's information
- ✓ Accompanied with an original birth certificate



Unacceptable affidavits...



- ✓ Person signing affidavit is not the parent/legal guardian
- ✓ A photocopied birth certificate has been submitted with the affidavit
- ✓ Not notarized

Proper proof of birth documents:

- ✓ ARS 15-828 states that the following proof of birth documents are acceptable when submitting paperwork for home school registration:
 - ✓ A CERTIFIED copy of the child's birth certificate.

- OR -

- ✓ Other reliable proof of the child's identity and age, including the child's baptismal certificate, an application for a social security number or original school registration records **AND** an affidavit explaining the inability to provide a copy of the birth certificate.

Notarization

- ✓ If the parent/legal guardian brings in the affidavit it can be notarized. This service is **FREE**.



Ages acceptable for home schooling

- ✓ ARS 15-802 states: that students between the ages of 6 and 16 must be registered in a public, private, charter, or home school.
